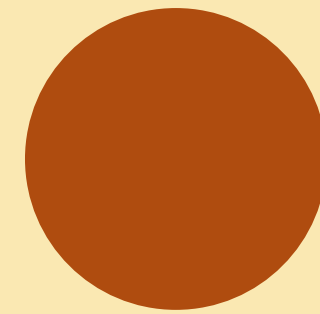

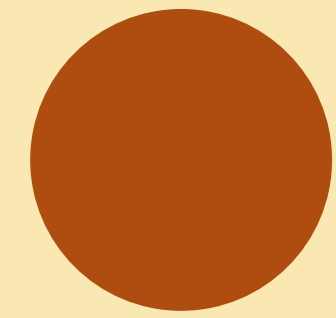
Music lesson one 4.9.25



Ariel class enjoyed learning about pulse and had an introduction to musical notation and singing in rounds.

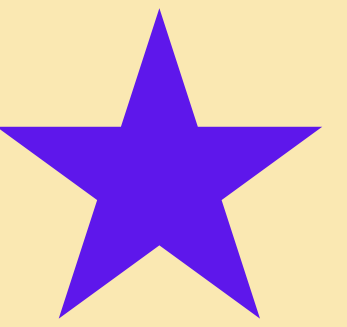


Music lesson two 11.9.25

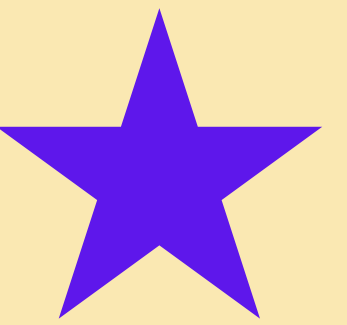

We had to follow the rules of the game.



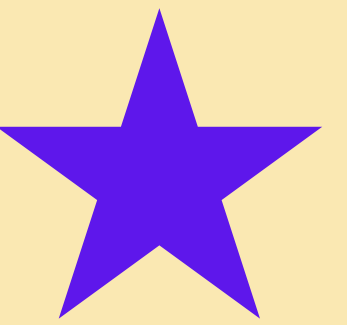

Robert McAlpine



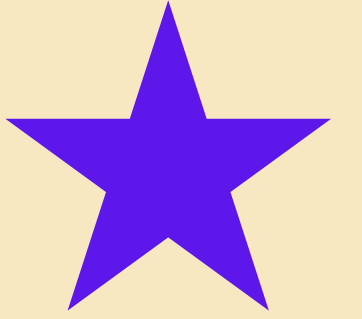
We were inspired by a group of engineers from, Sir Robert McAlpine. We learned that 'People like Me' can have careers in STEM.

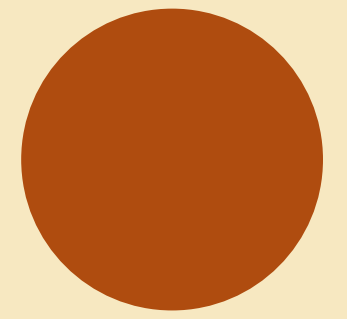


We worked in small groups to move around as we threw the ball to each other. Things got tricky today!

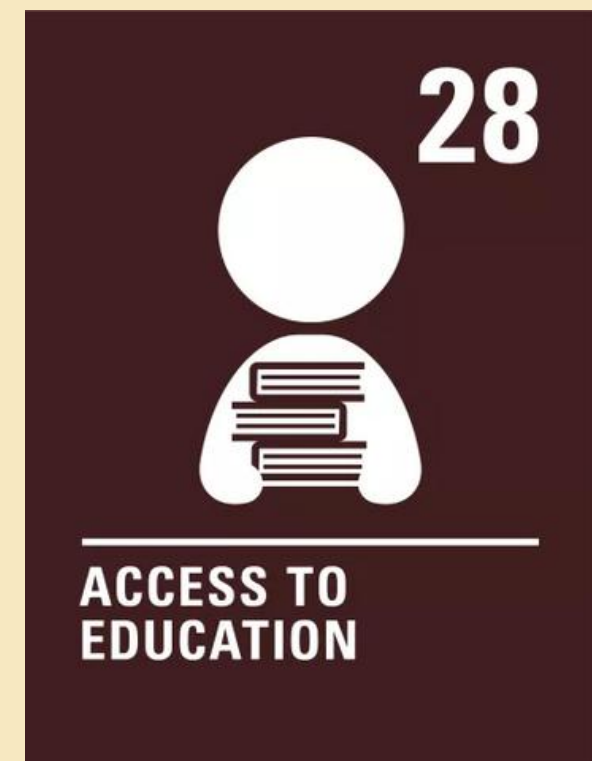


The Silver Sword

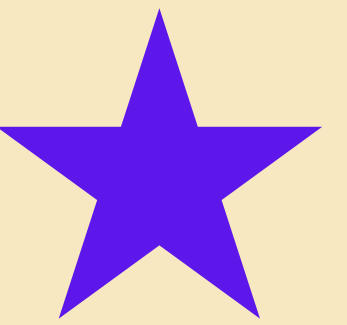

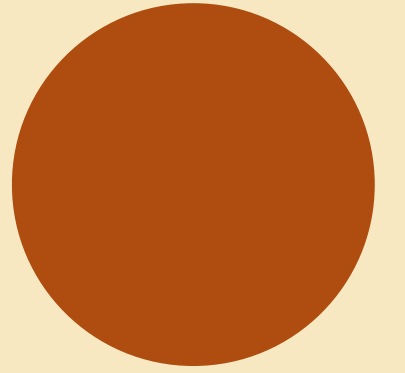
We played some competitive tag rugby games today. Everyone demonstrated an understanding of how to play the game and communicated with each other very well.

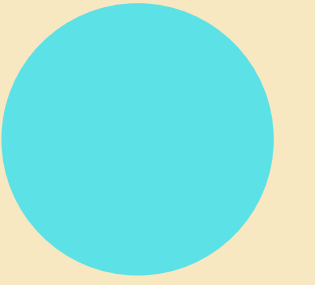

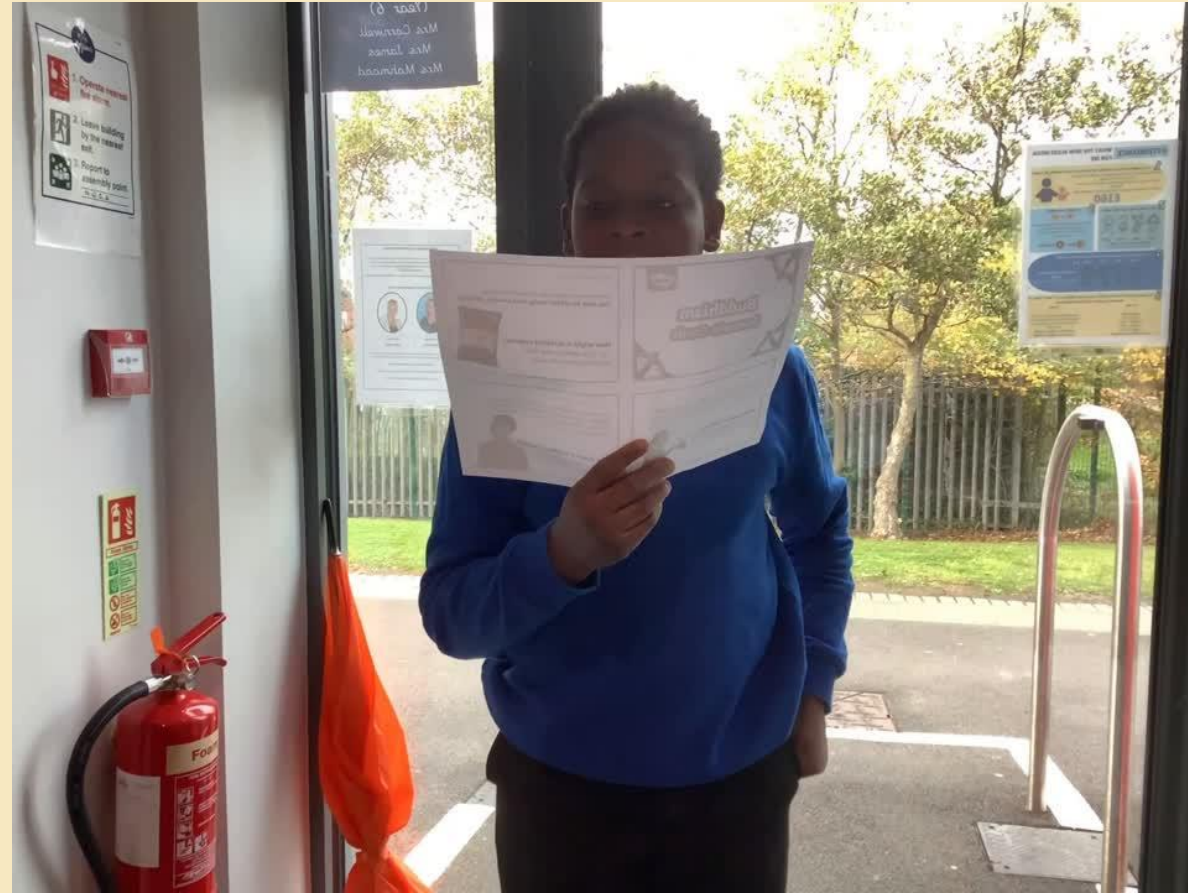

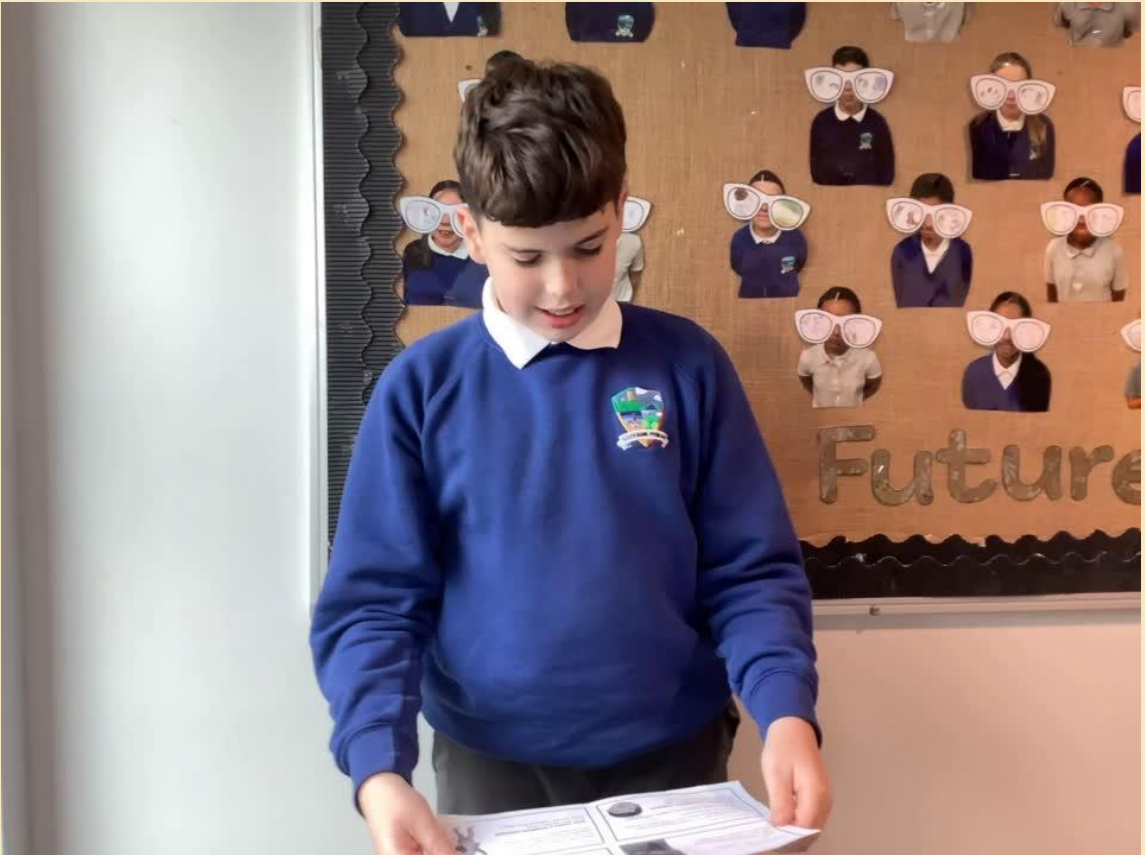
The eightfold path
