In today's jigsaw lesson, we have been thinking about rewards and consequences. Our task was to think of our own set of classroom rules and a reward and consequence for each rule.



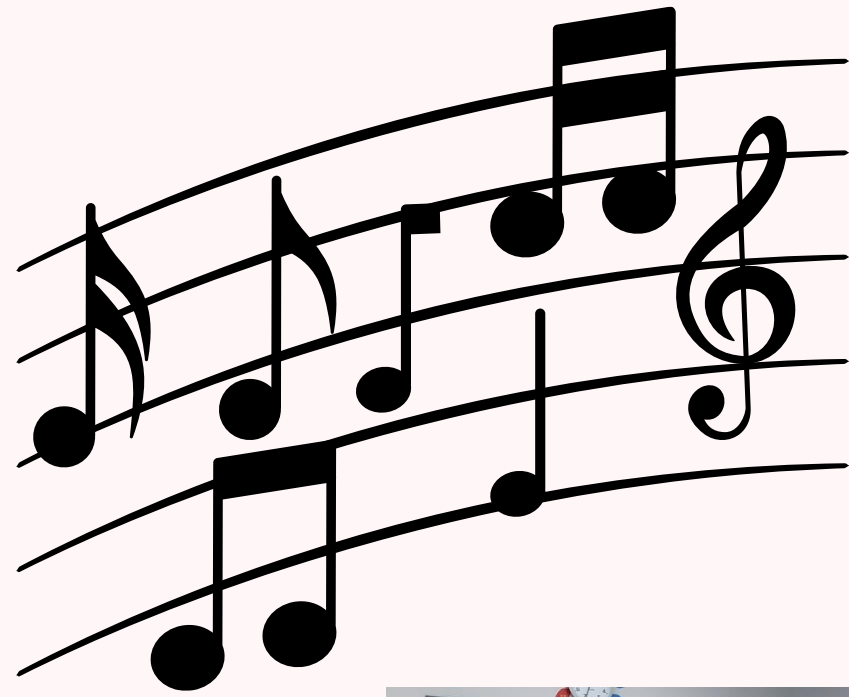
Show racism the red card Riverside Stadium 01.10.25

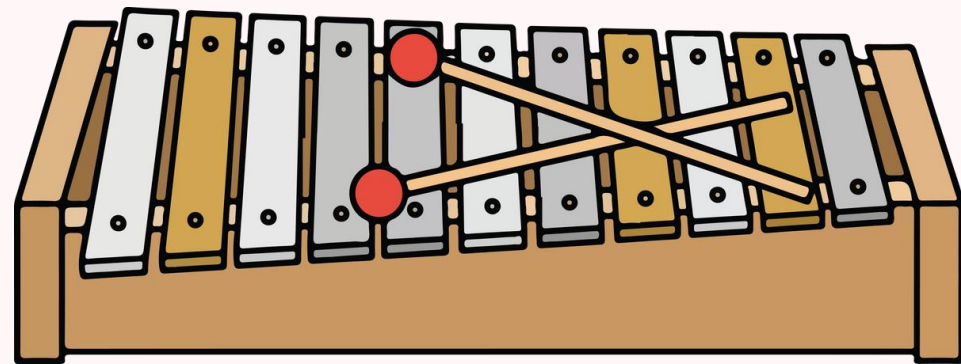

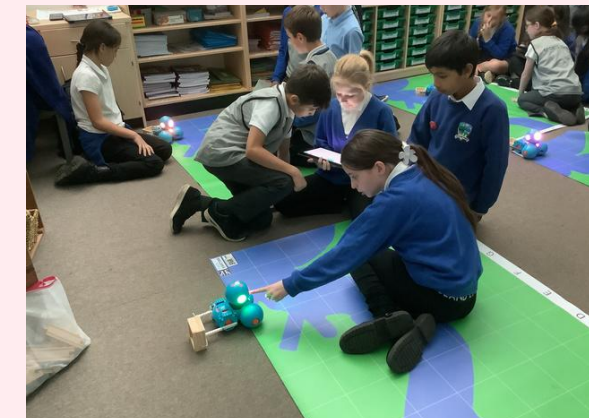
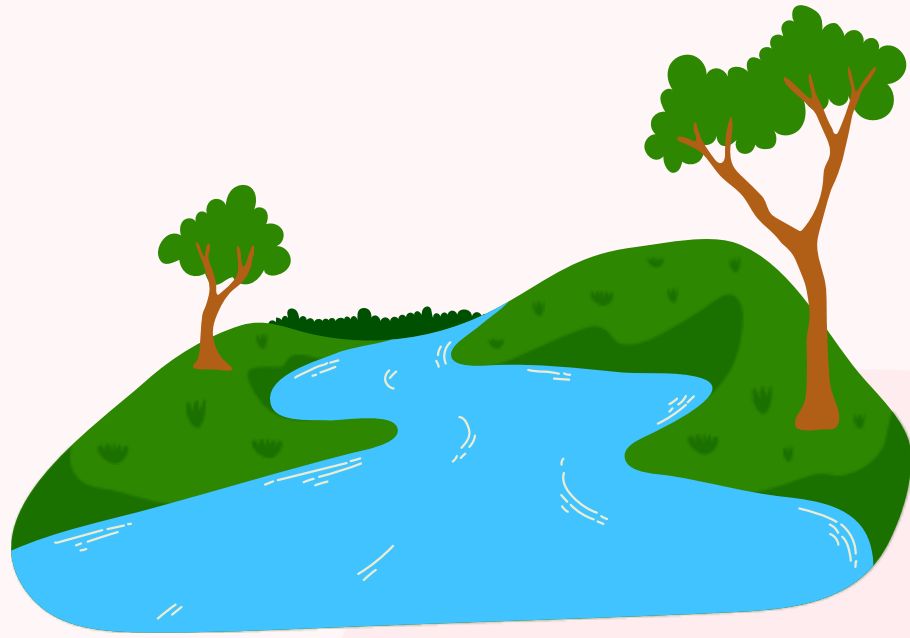
