

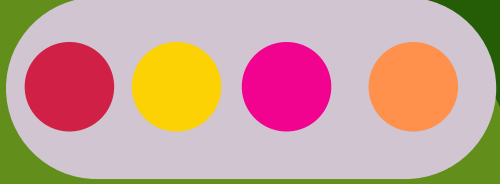

The children arranged the chairs independently into a bus, adults extended the children's play singing the 'the wheels on the bus' and modelling the actions

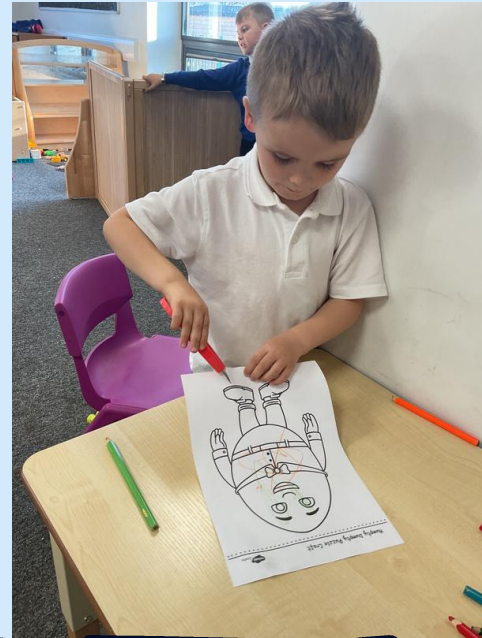


Magical counting wand



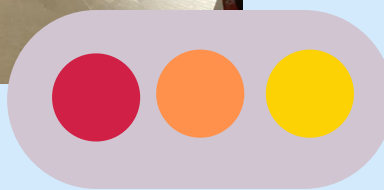
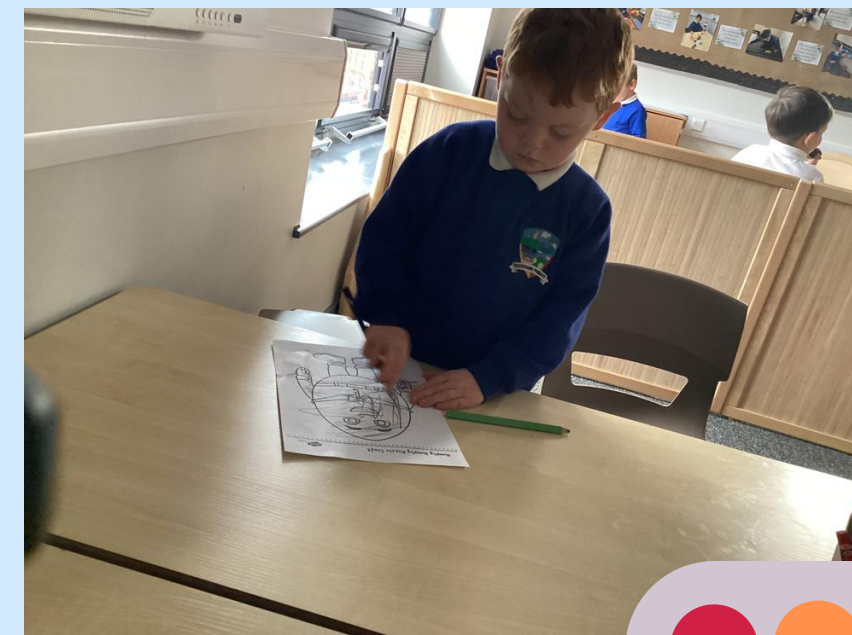
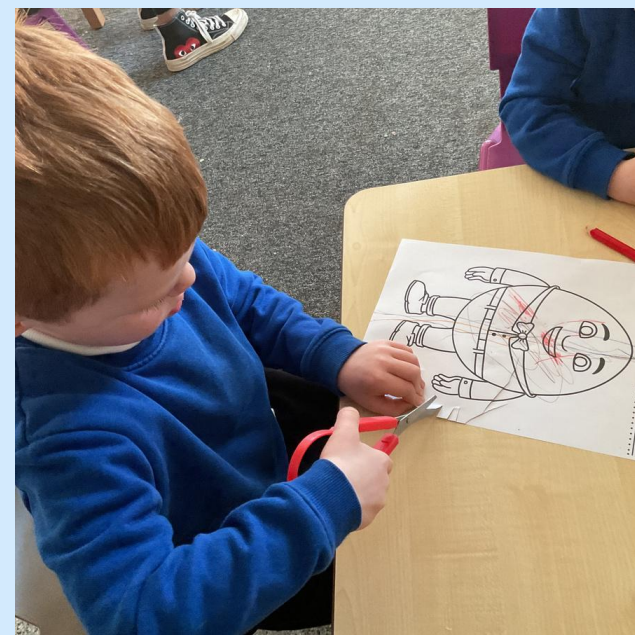
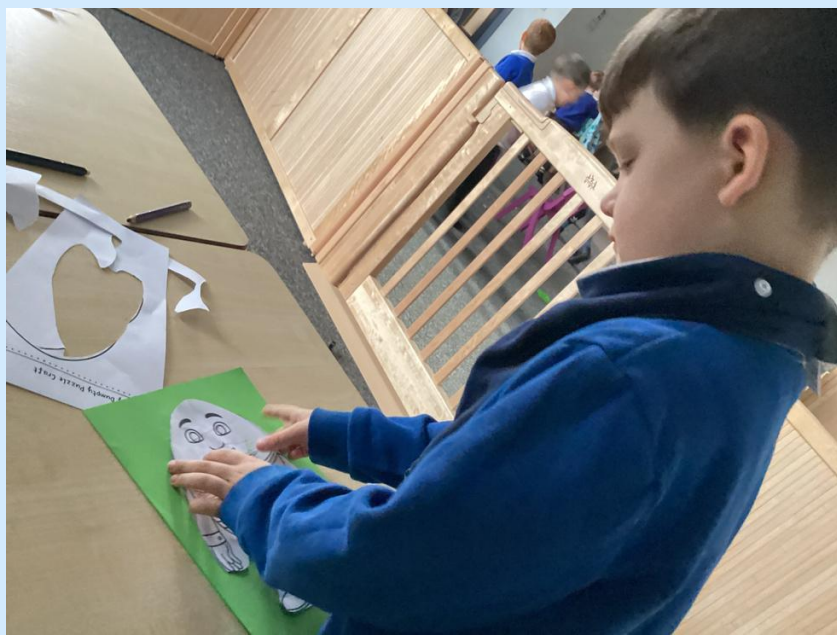
The children used tissue paper of their own choosing to create their own magical counting wand

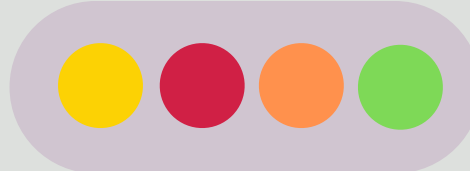




HANDPRINT LIGHTS

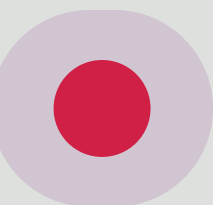
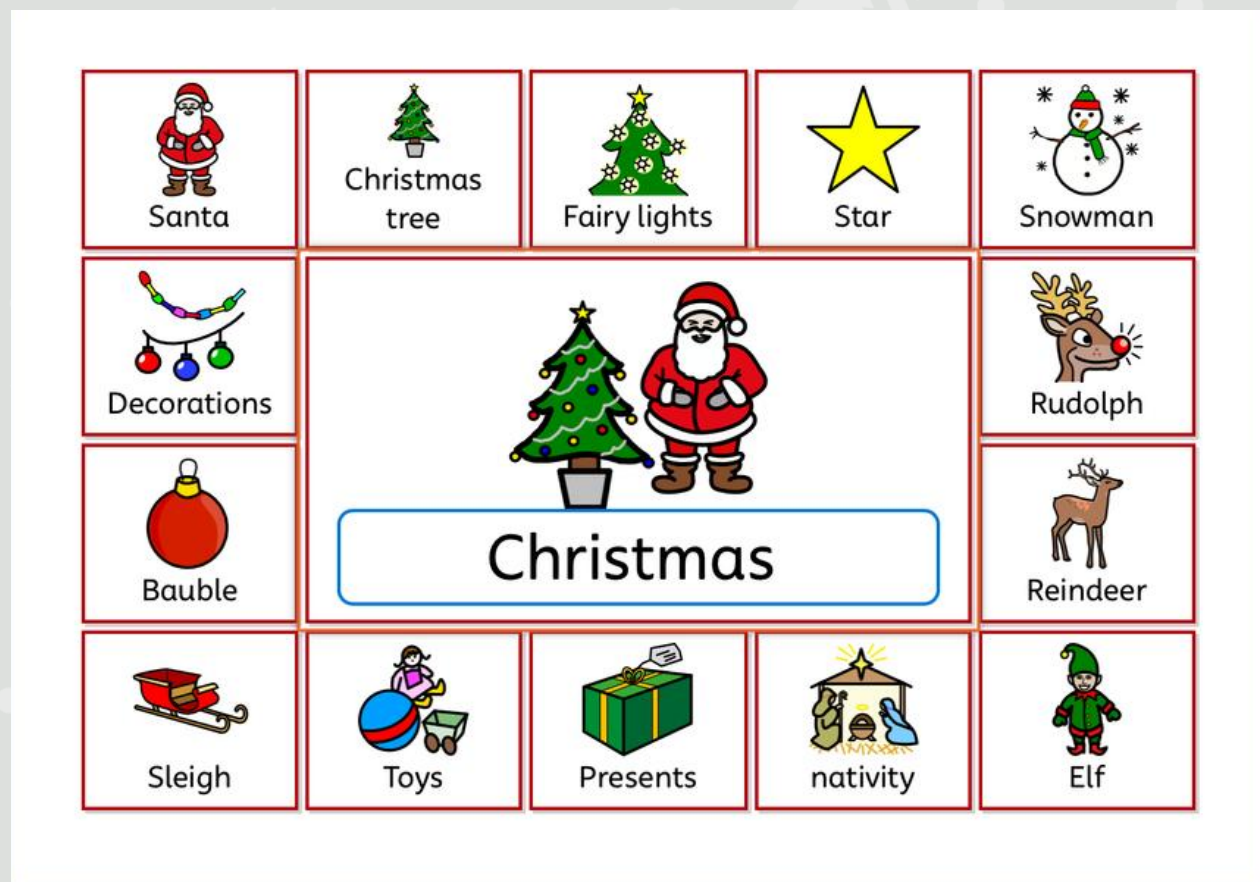

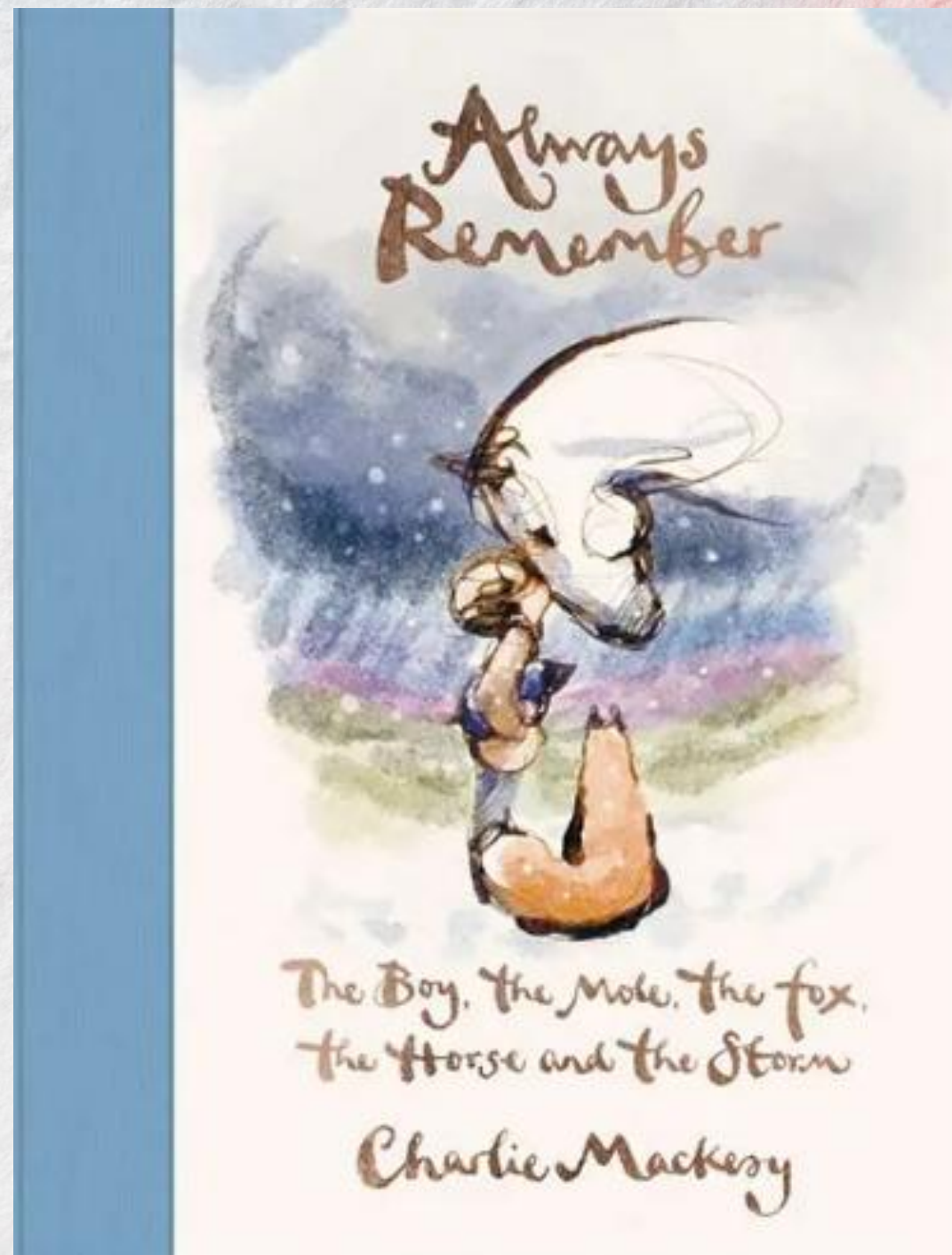


We shared communication boards with home to support our communication and understanding about Christmas and traditions

We focussed on this book for our drawing club sessions, exploring the characters and settings in depth

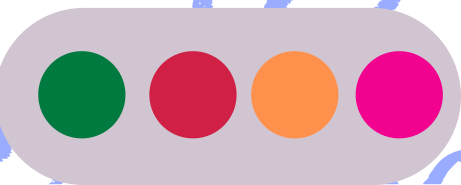

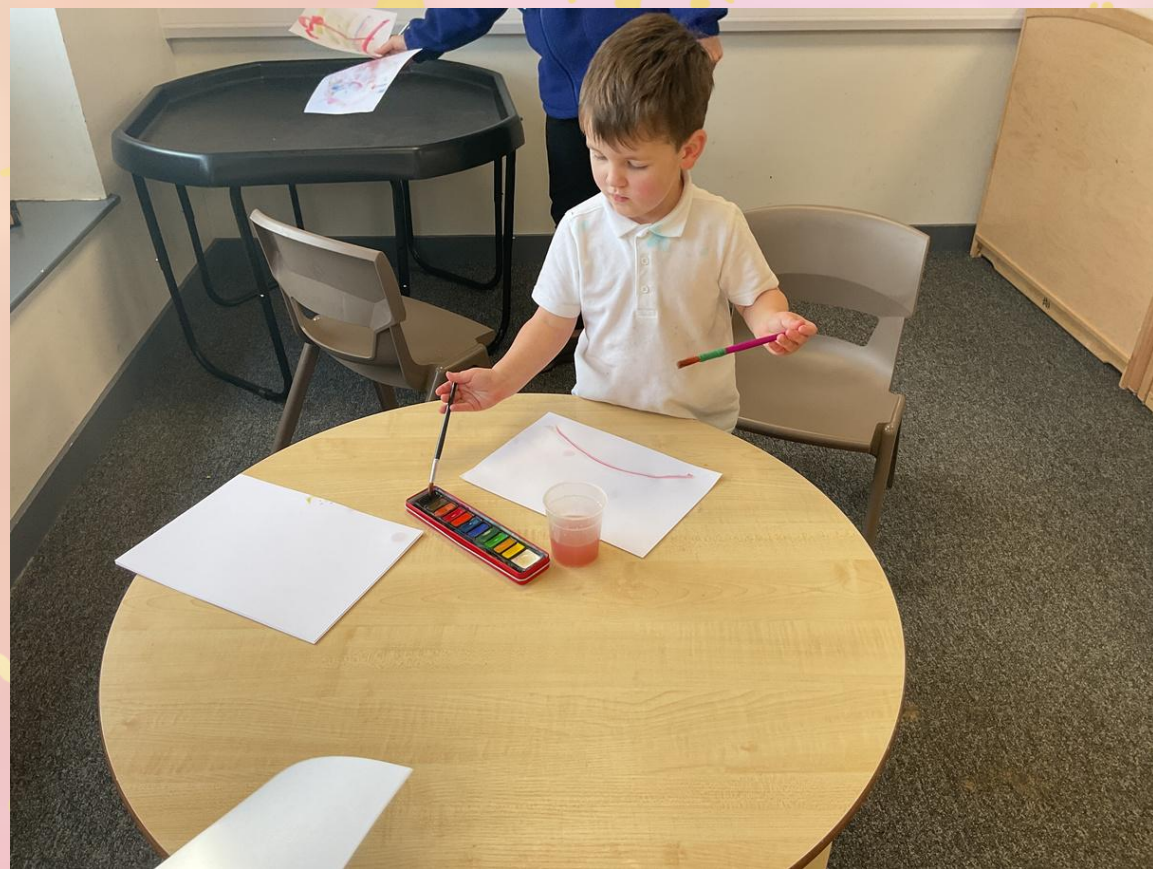

our own rainbows

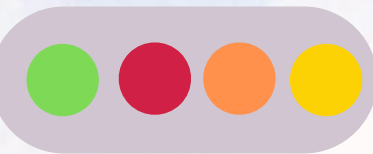
The adults spoke about

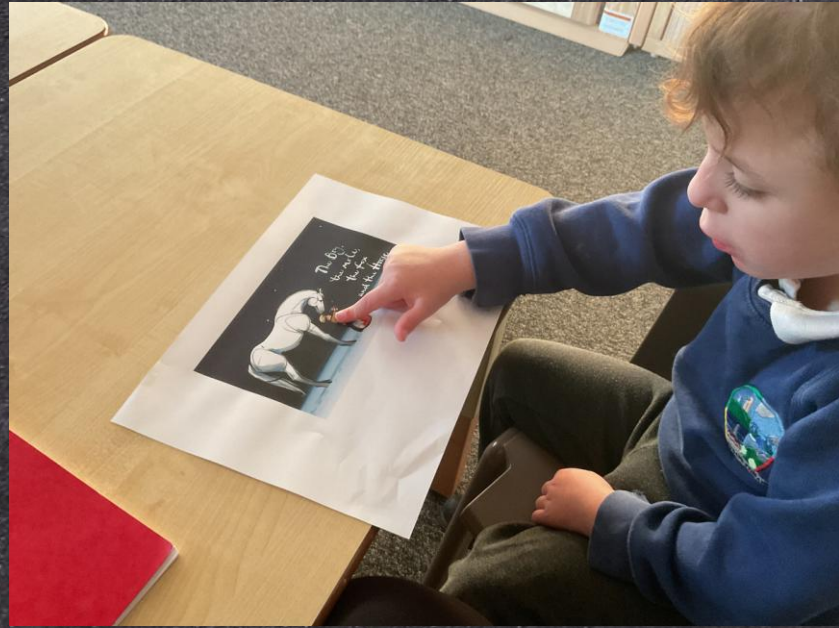
Painting hearts

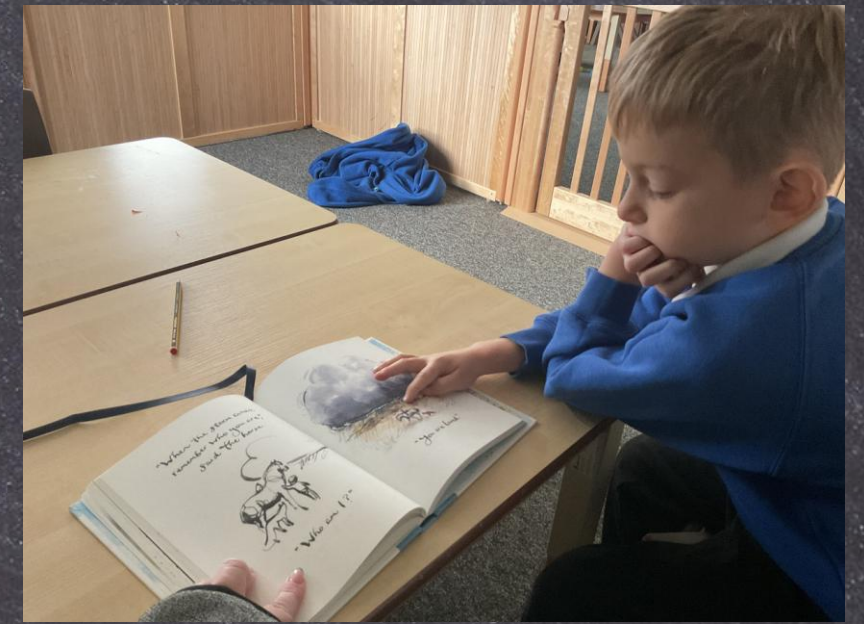
In drawing club this week, we have...



chose our favourite setting from the story, and drew this in our books



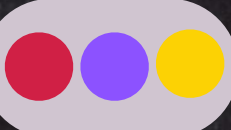
looked at different settings in the story before choosing one and drawing it

Snowy

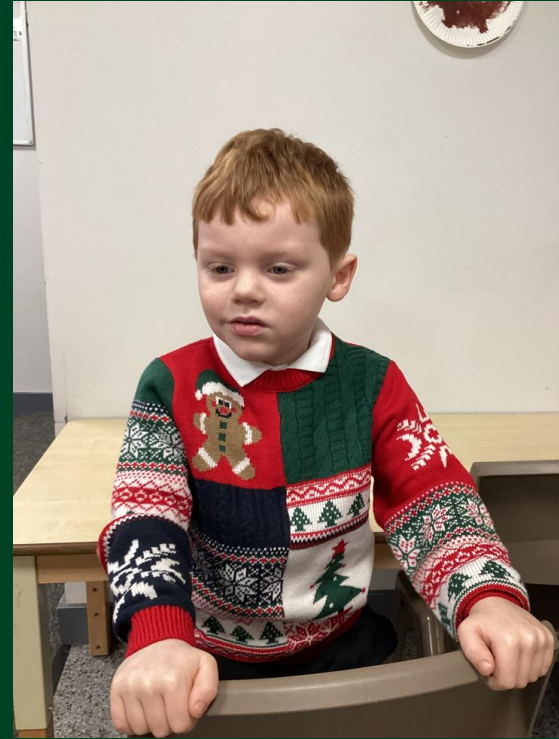
