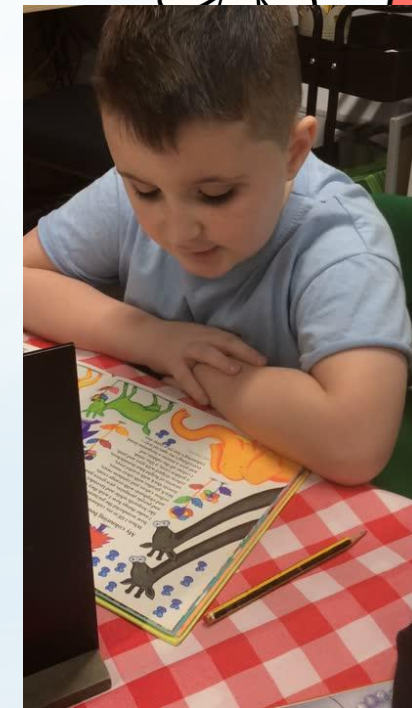
# Reading Café

We enjoyed a morning with our parents and carers for 'Book and Breakfast'. We enjoyed books, croissants and time with our families sharing stories we love.

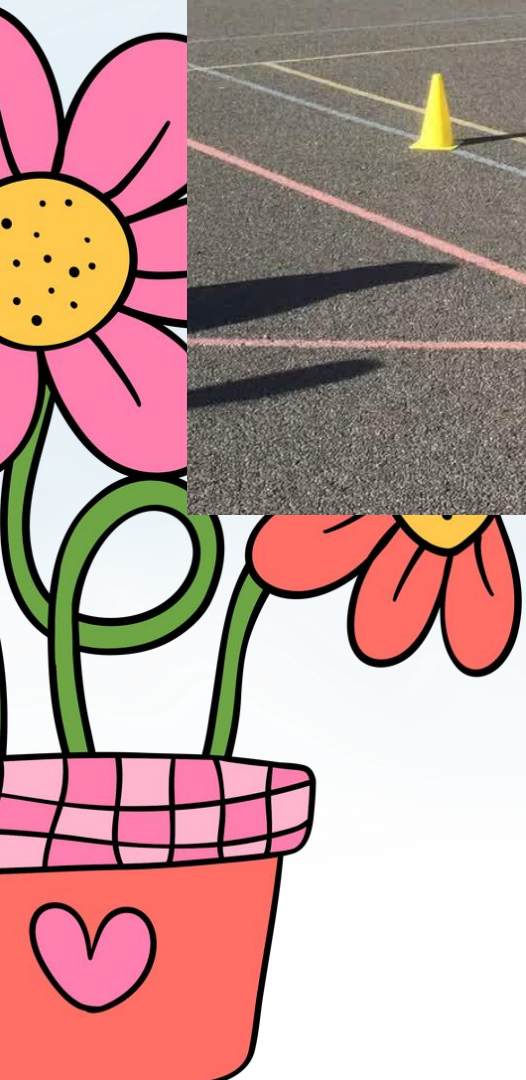


# PE- Ball Skills: Feet (MFC)

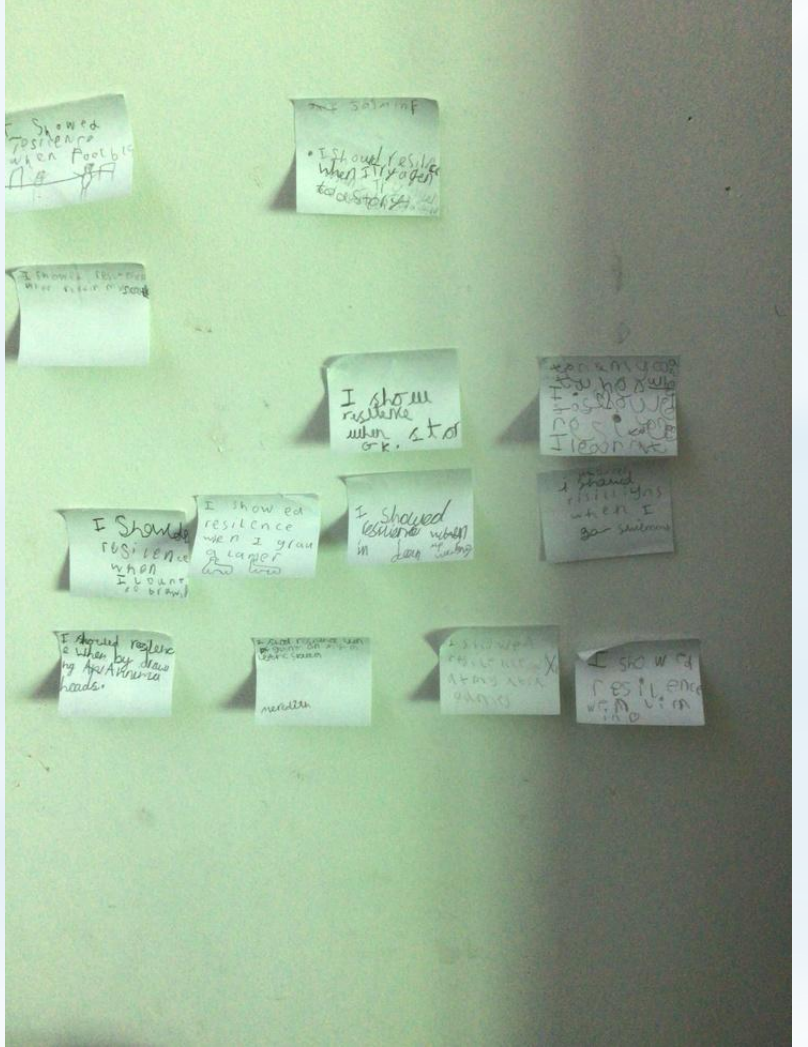

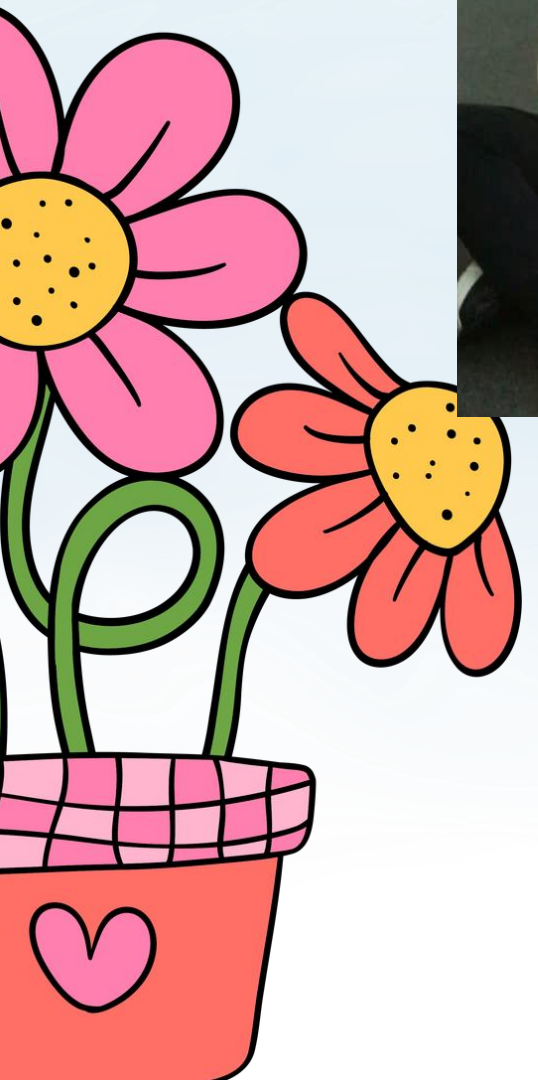
# - Resilience

6. Finally, get a soft tissue to dry your hands! Don't leave water on your hands.

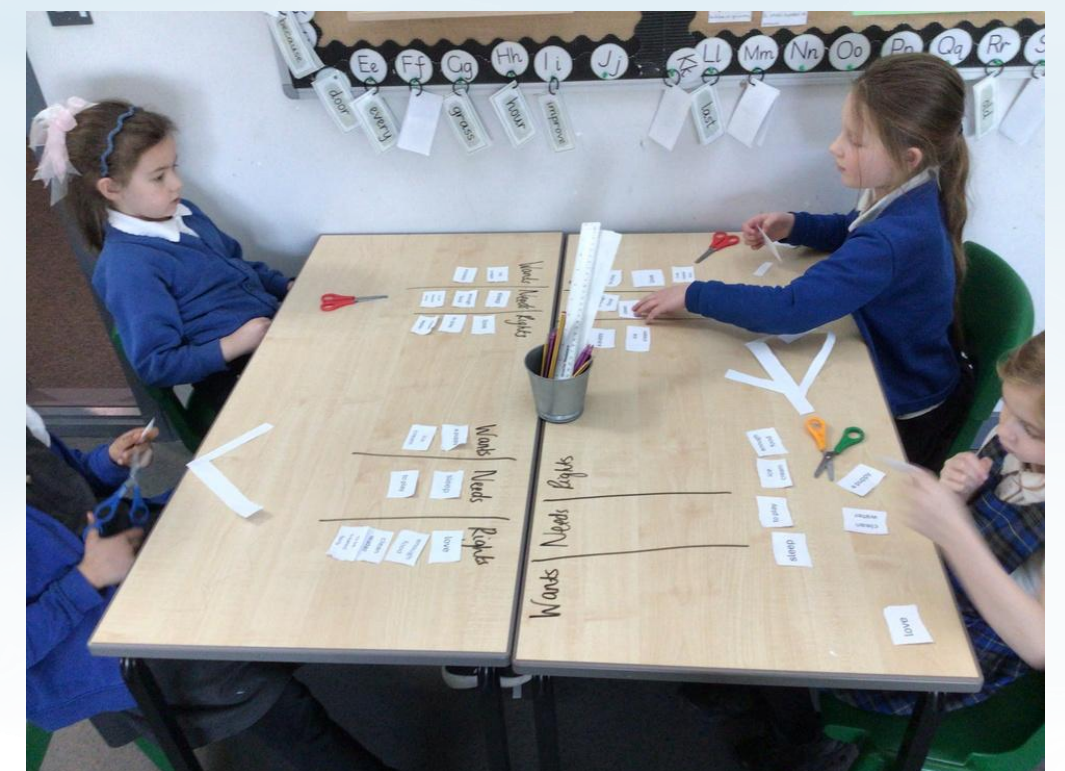
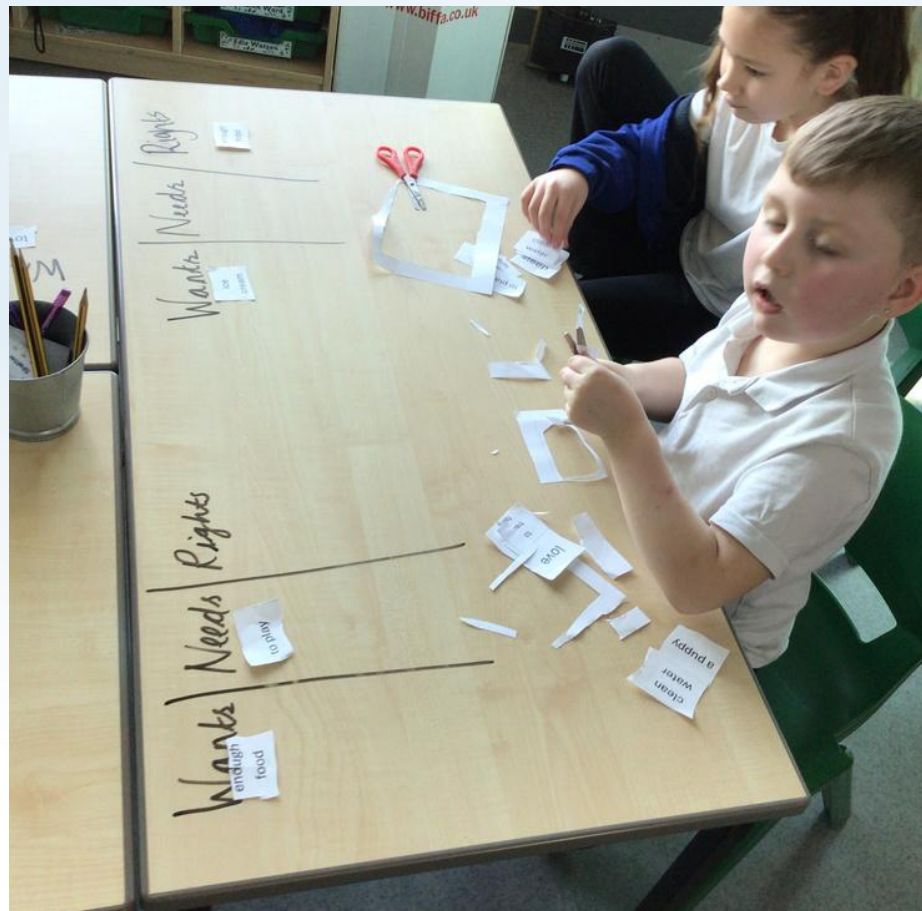
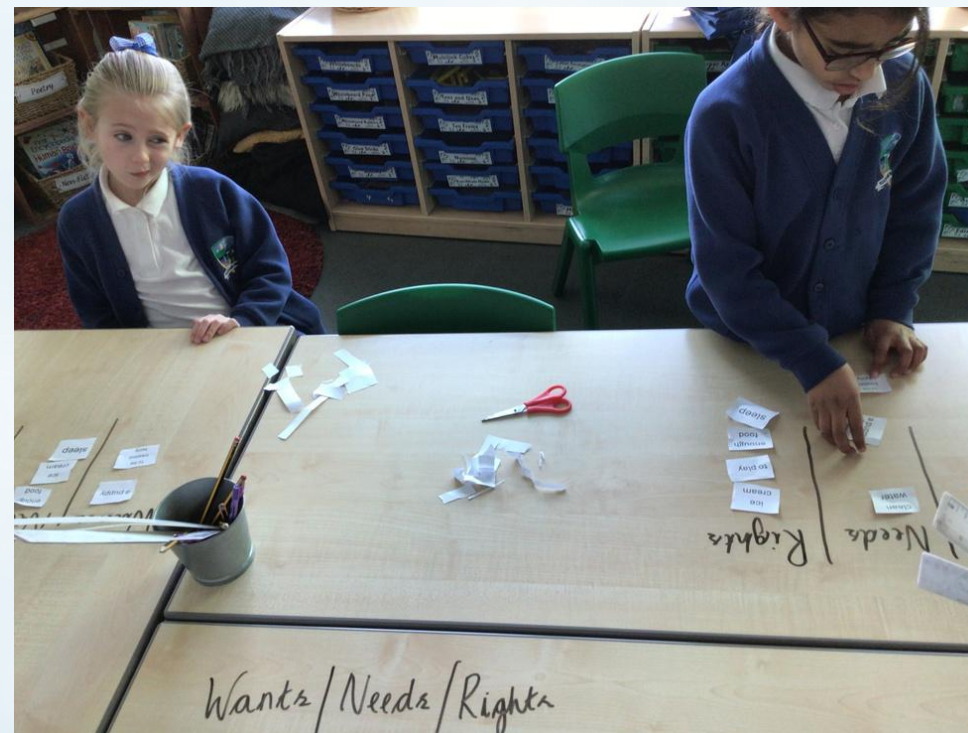
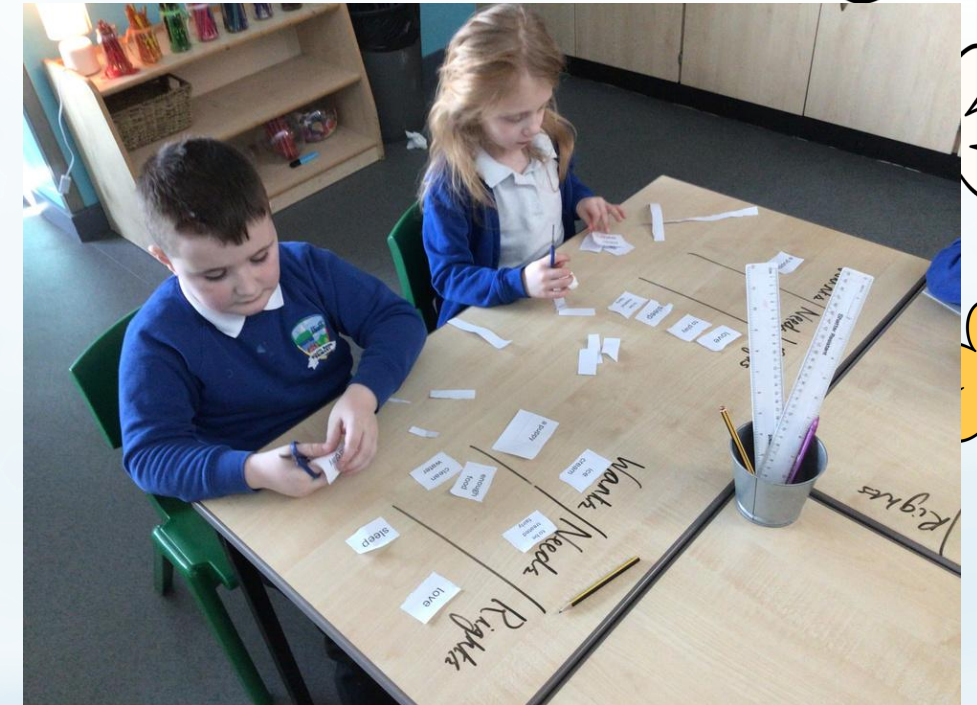
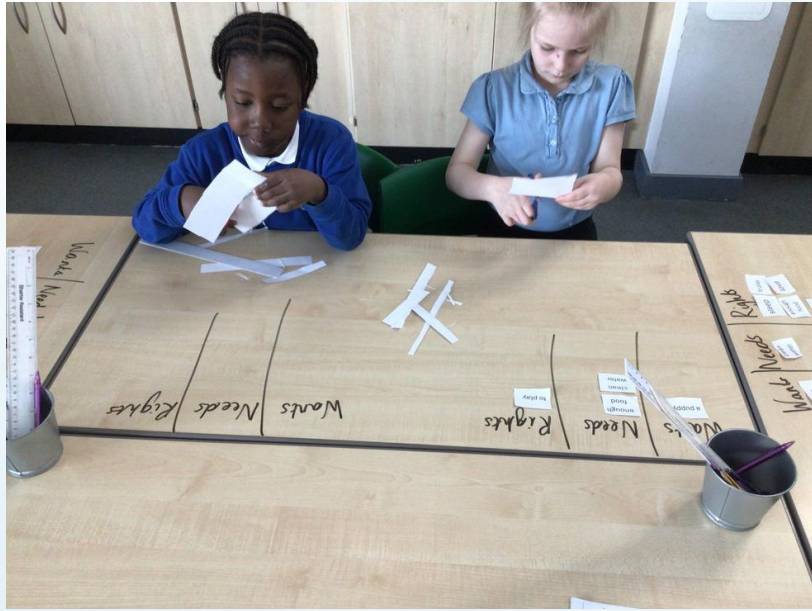

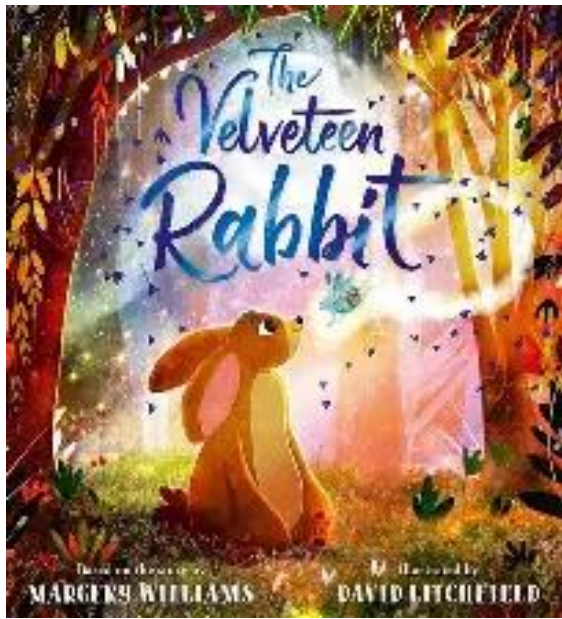
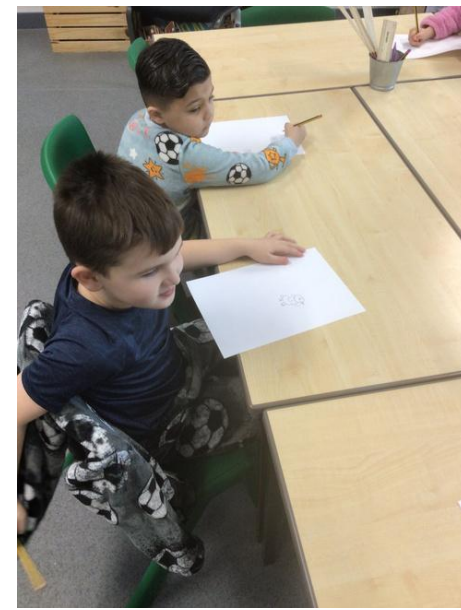


**We celebrated World Book Day by dressing as characters from our favourite books.**

**Gwendolyn created her own story in a box at home.**



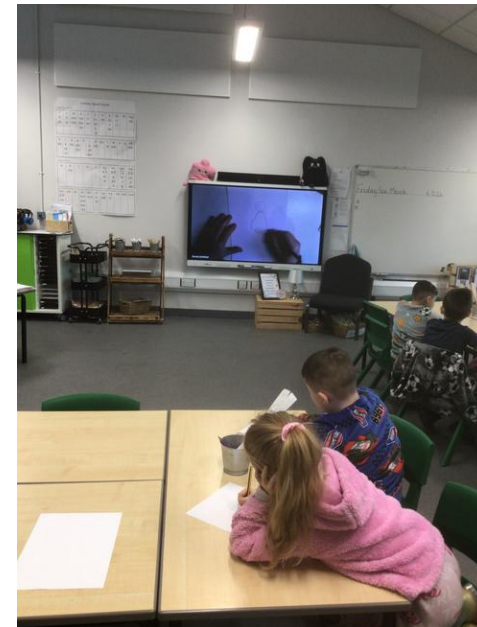
# Book Share & Draw Along

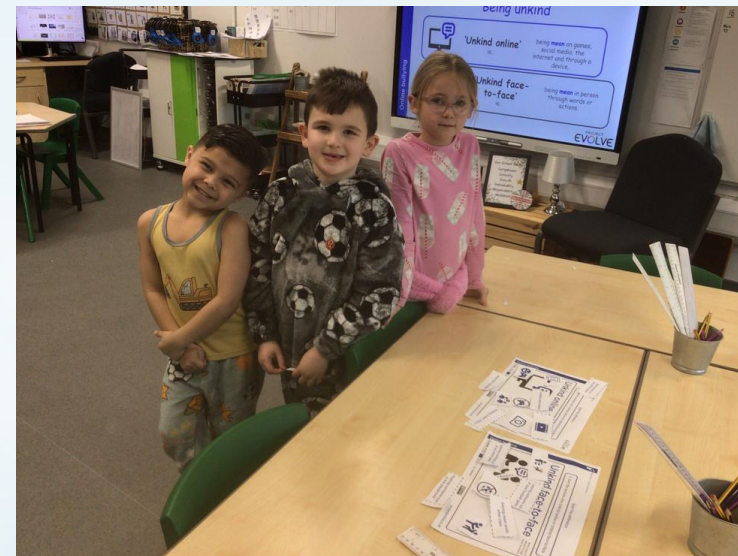
We talked about online bullying and managing bullying online. We talked about how different scenarios would make Merri feel.

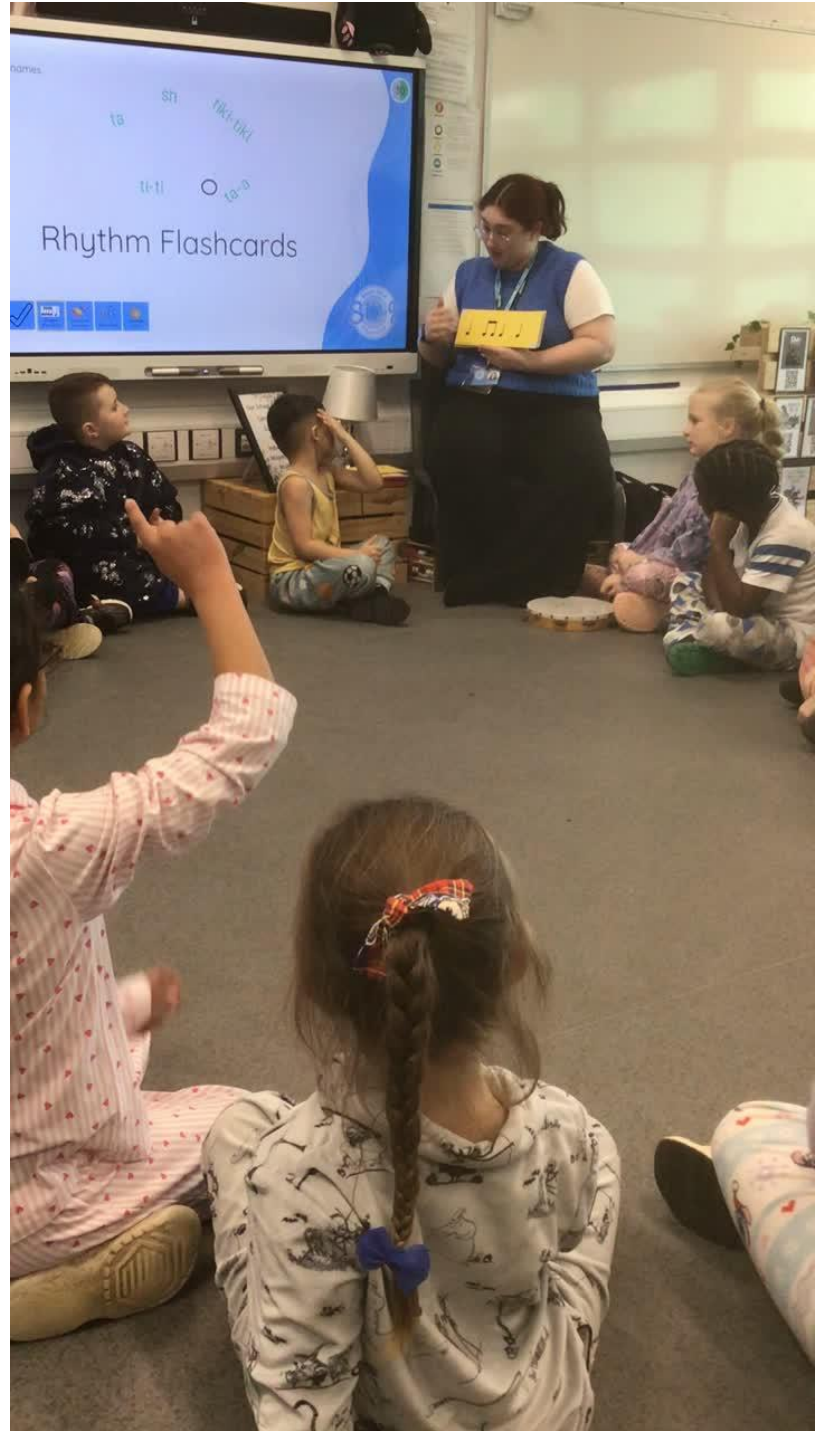

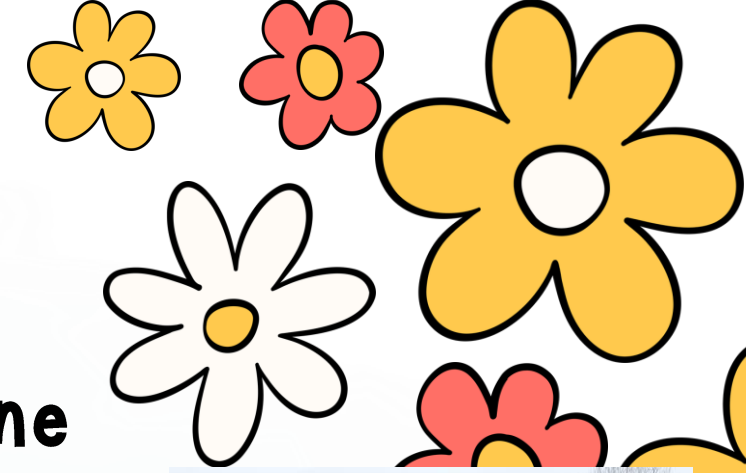
**In our spelling lesson today, we played a 'would you rather' game by practising using the superlative suffix -est.**

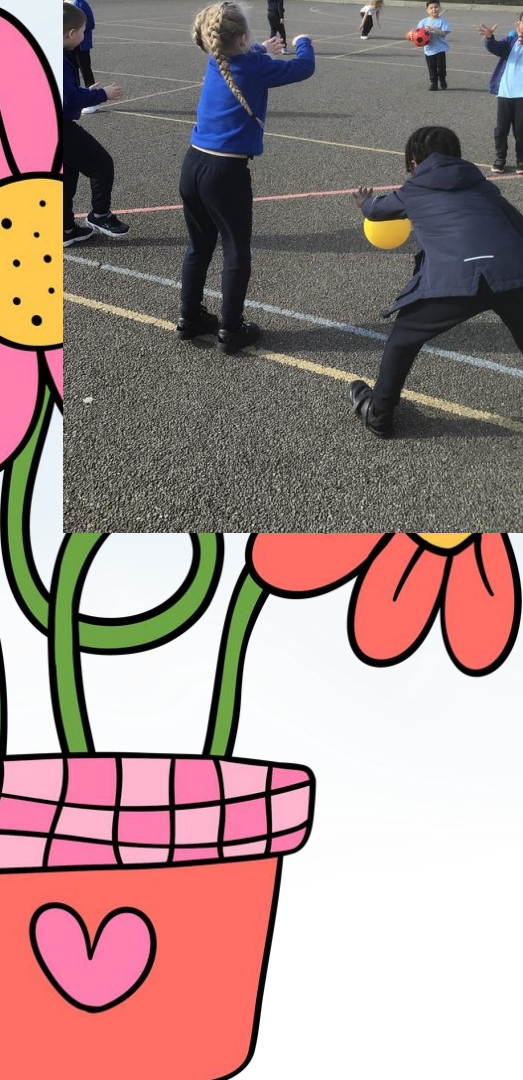

We passed the ball between our team and moved to a different cone.



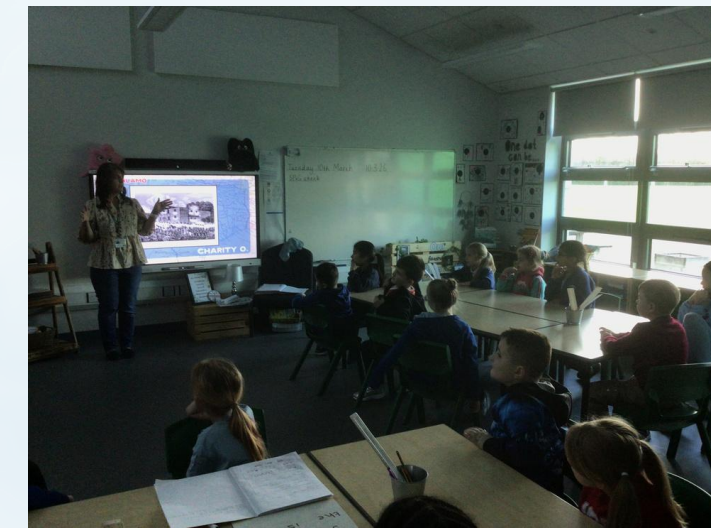
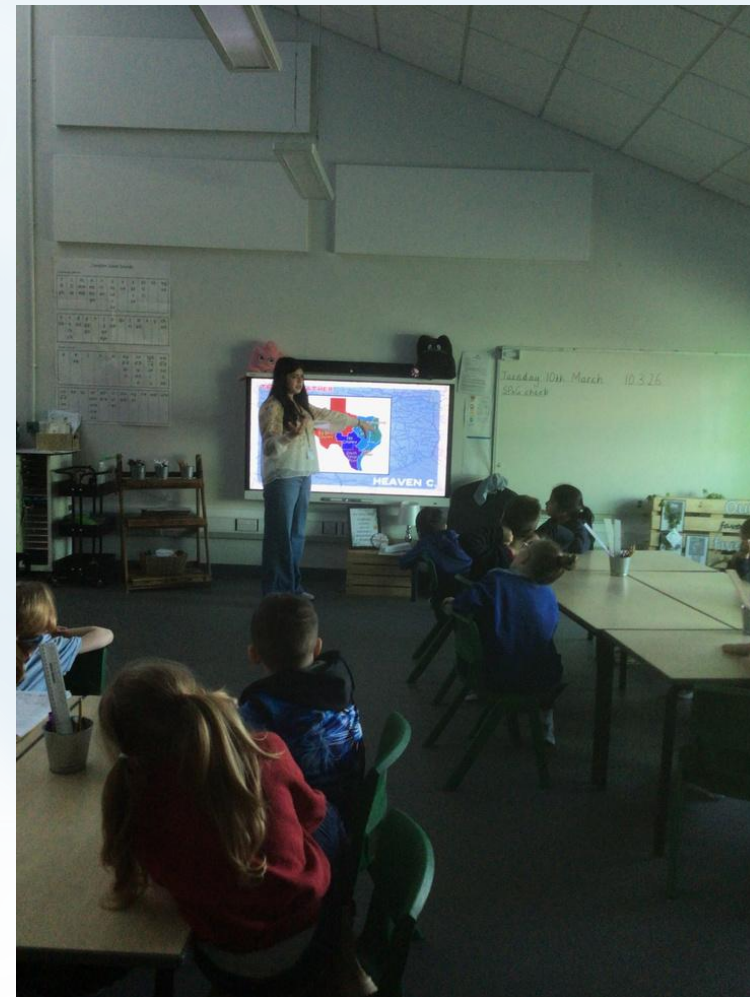
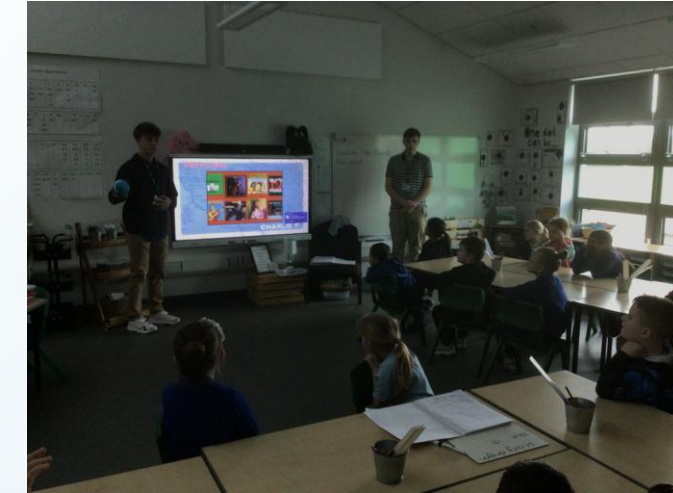
Once we practised this, we moved onto the skill of dribbling the ball with our hands.

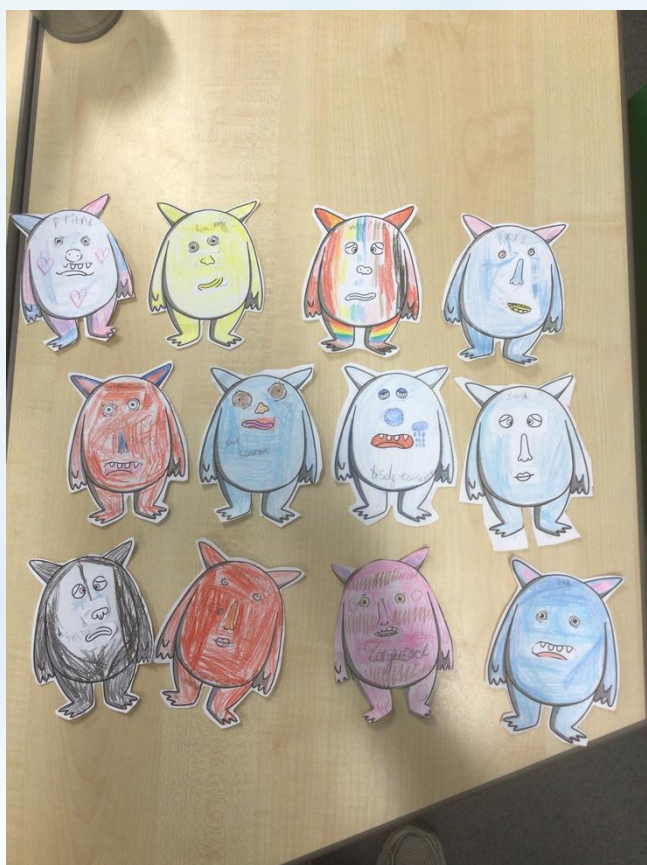

# British Science Week

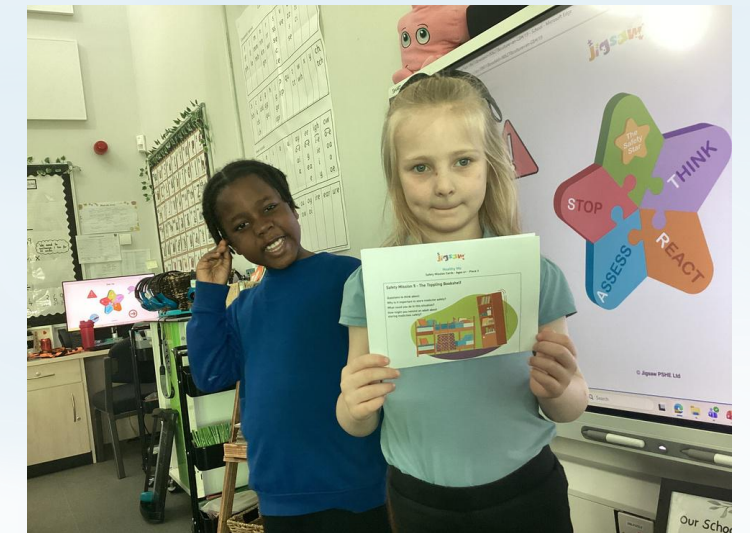

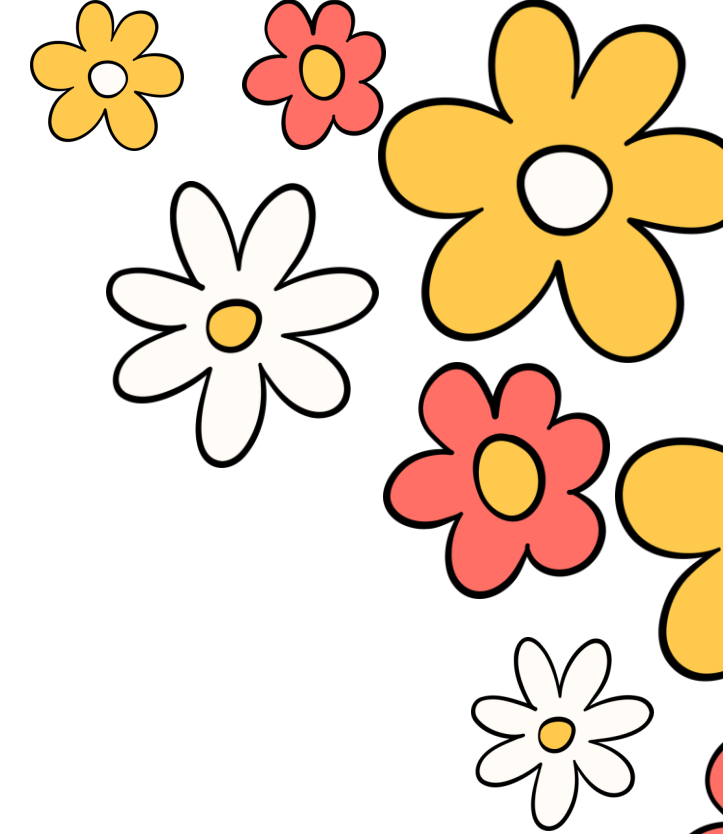
# DT - Make a product
