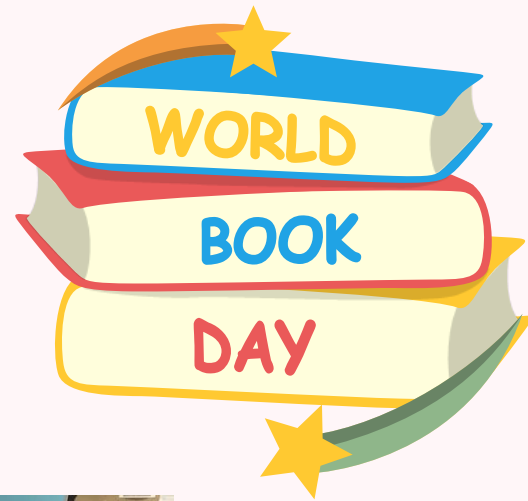


In computing today, we have been learning how to use the pages app. We watched a tutorial video by Andrew Stockdale and followed his instructions step by step.

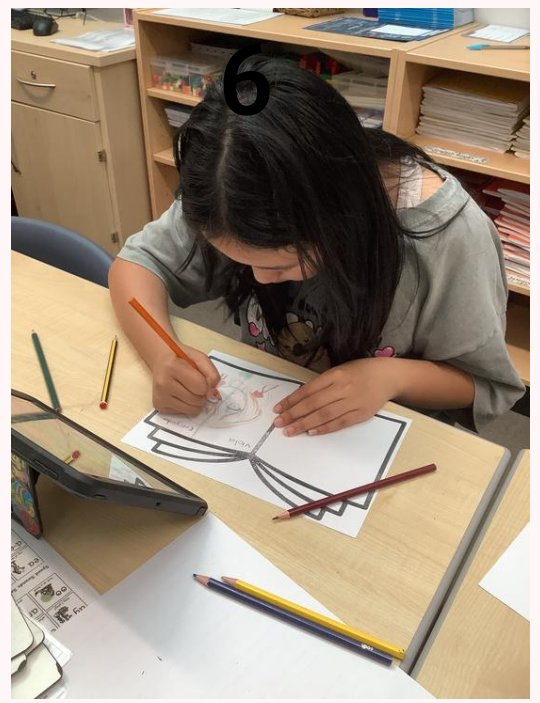
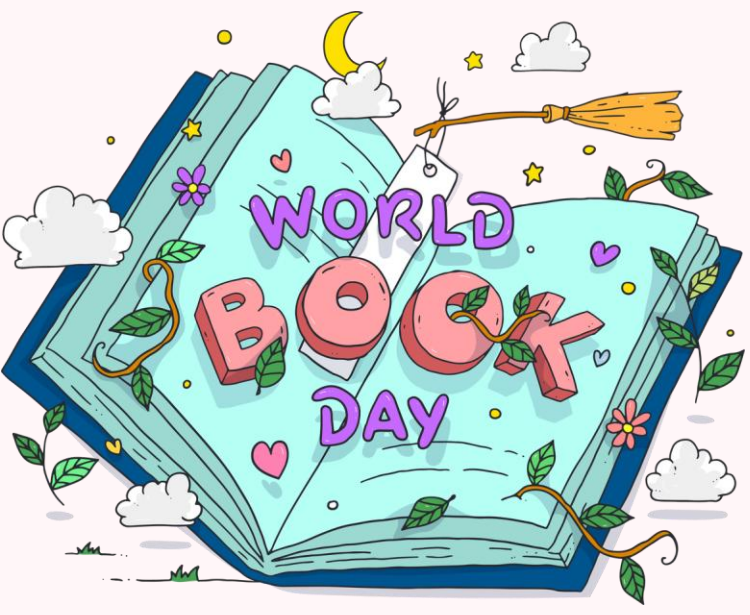

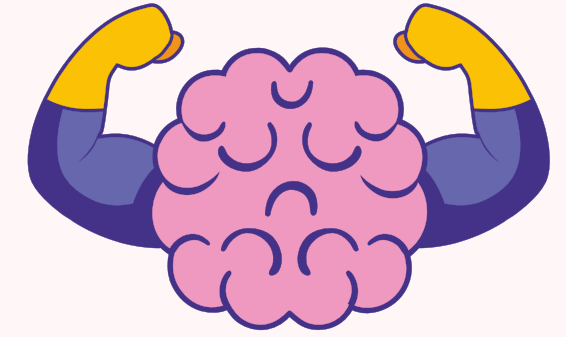
WORLD BOOK DAY

we took part in lots of fun activities for world book day! Some of us made a story in a shoebox, we exchanged our book tokens and we designed our own front covers of our favourite books.

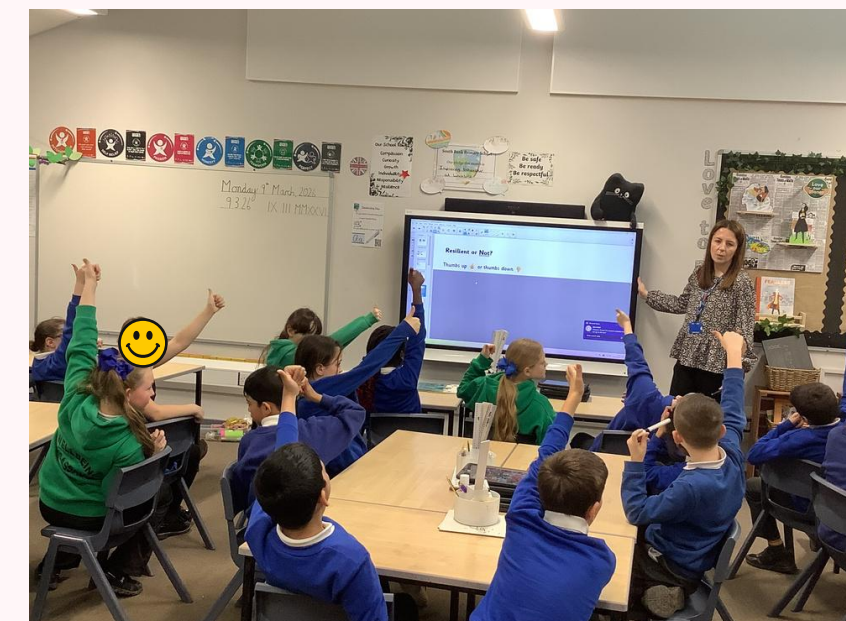
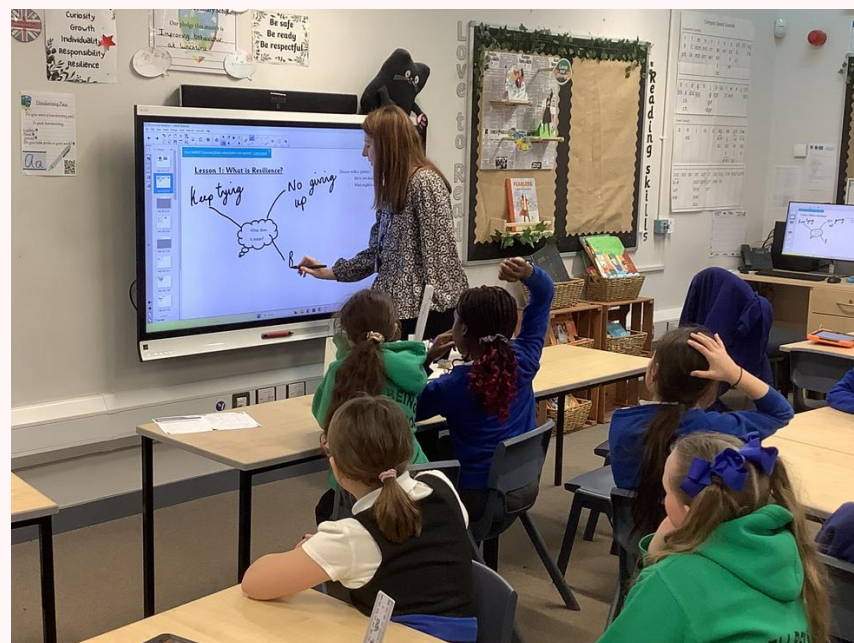
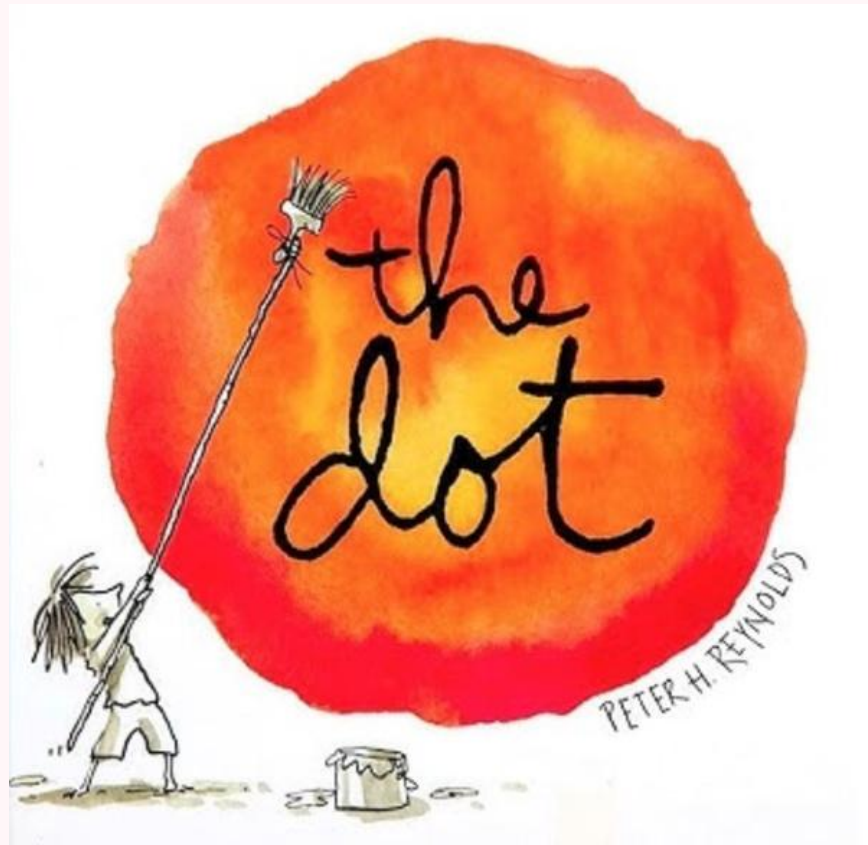




Aspirations assembly 09.03.26



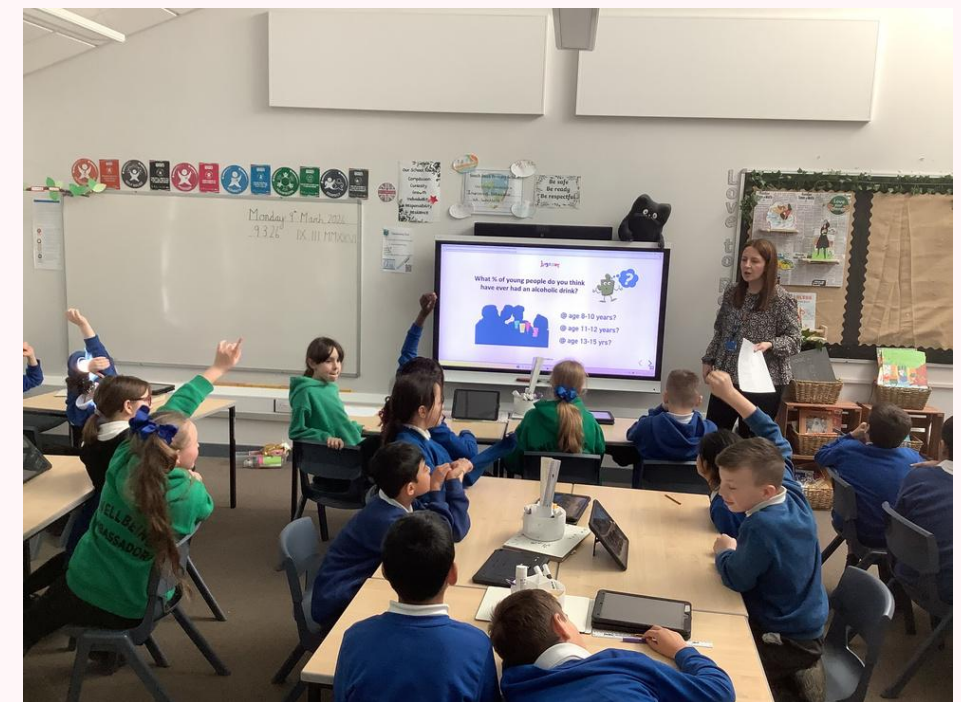
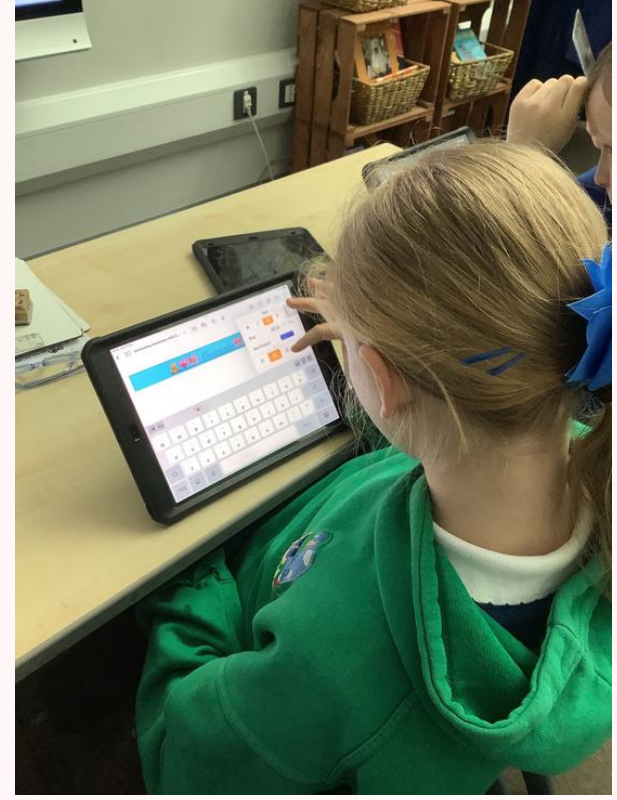
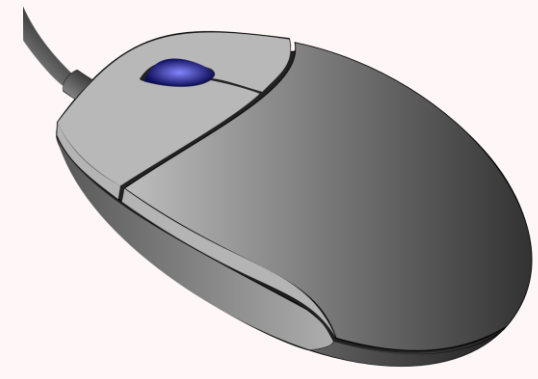

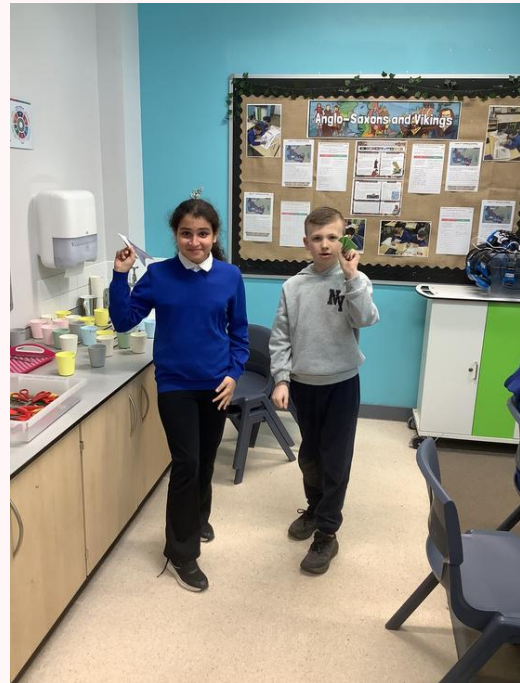
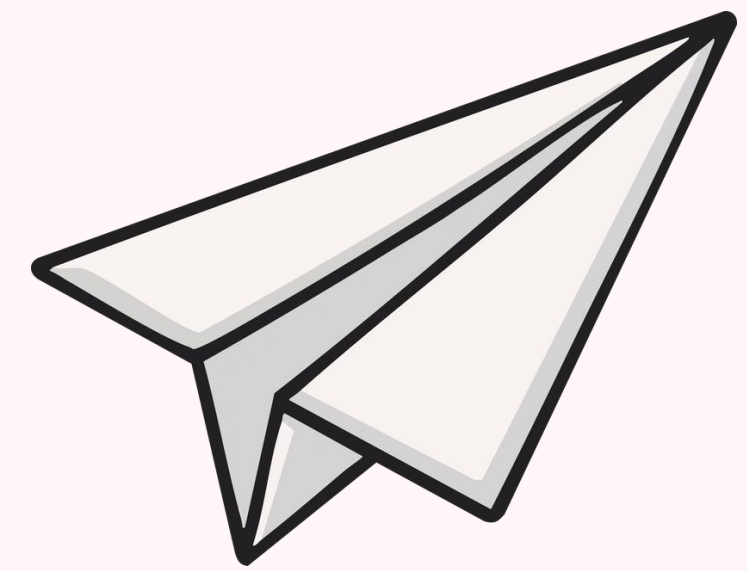
We have been continuing with the pages tutorials with Andrew Stockdale in our lesson today.

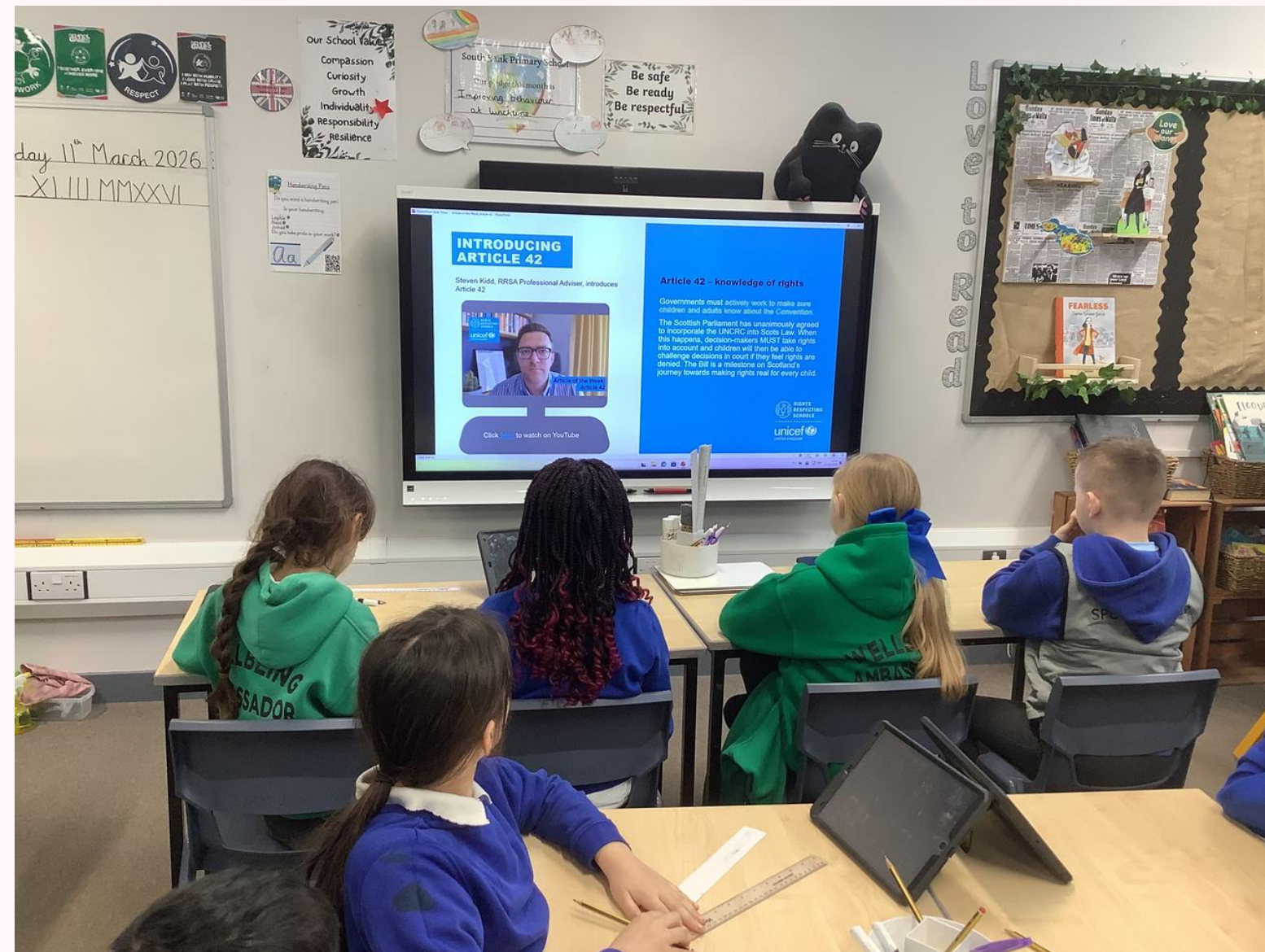


Rights respecting 11.03.26

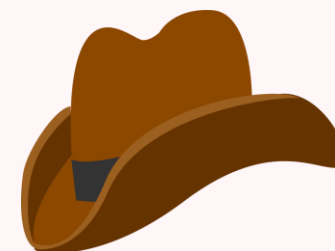


Visitors from Texas

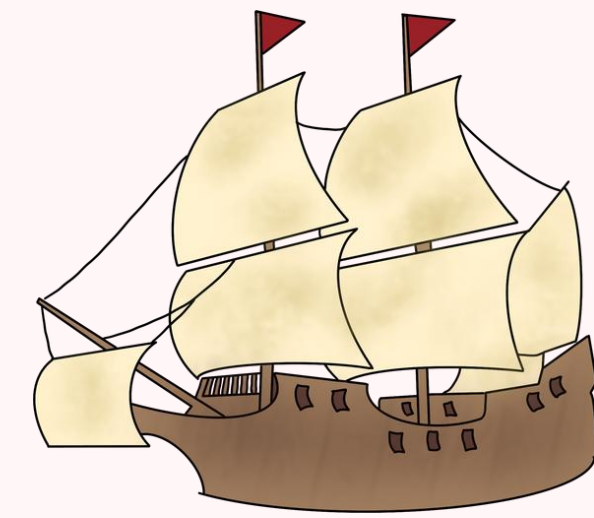


We were very lucky to have some visitors from Texas! We had the opportunity to ask lots of questions about what about what life is like in Texas and we learned how to line dance.

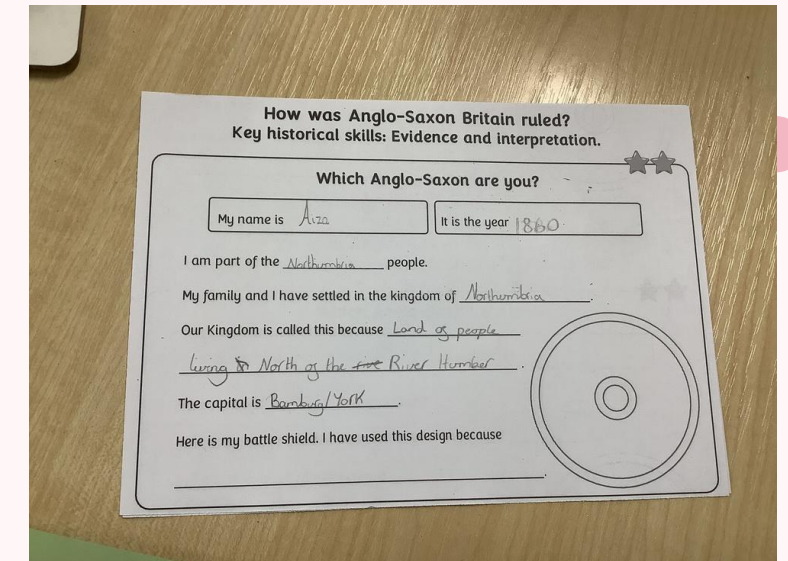
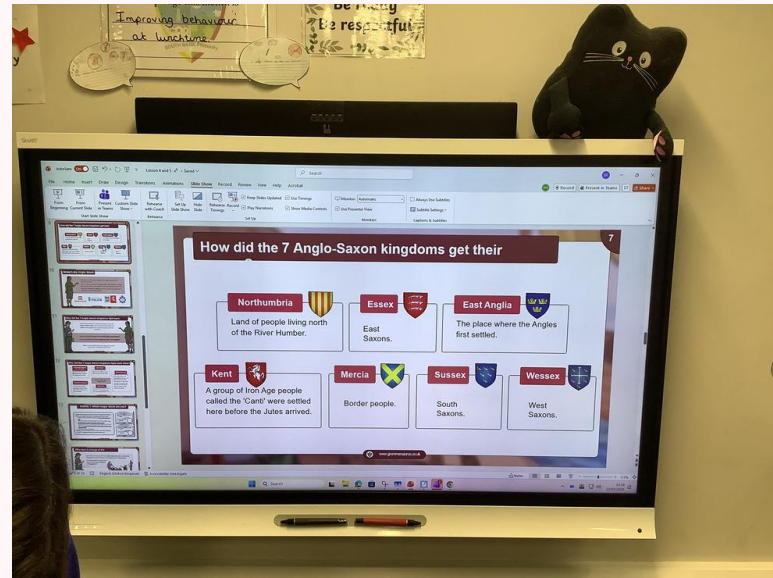

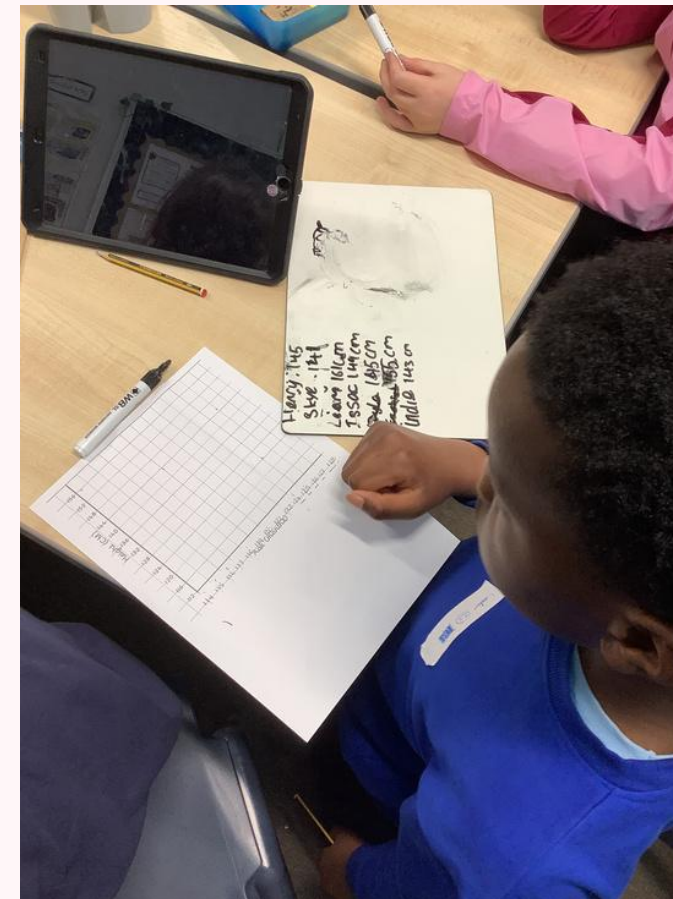
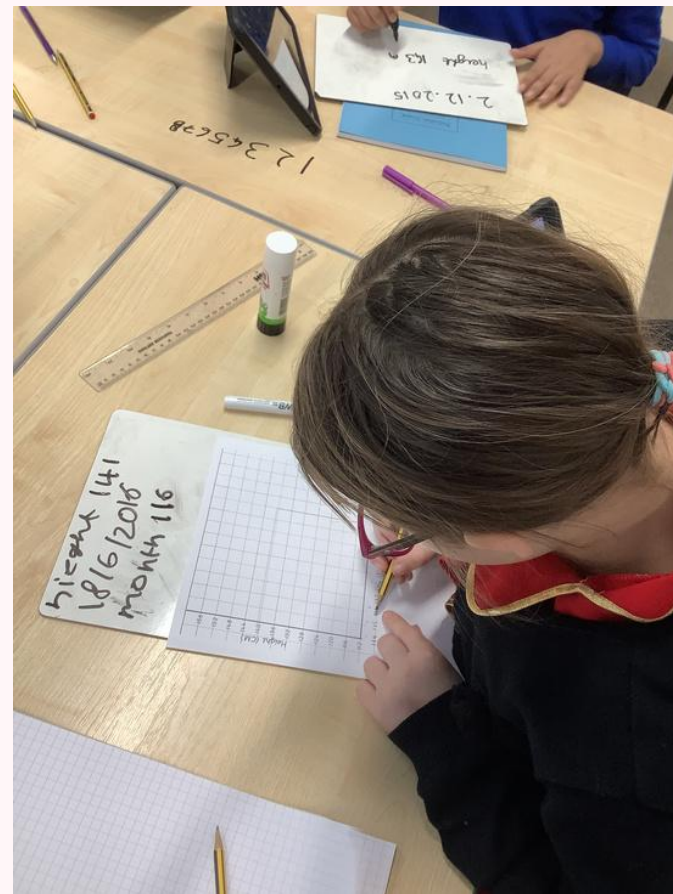
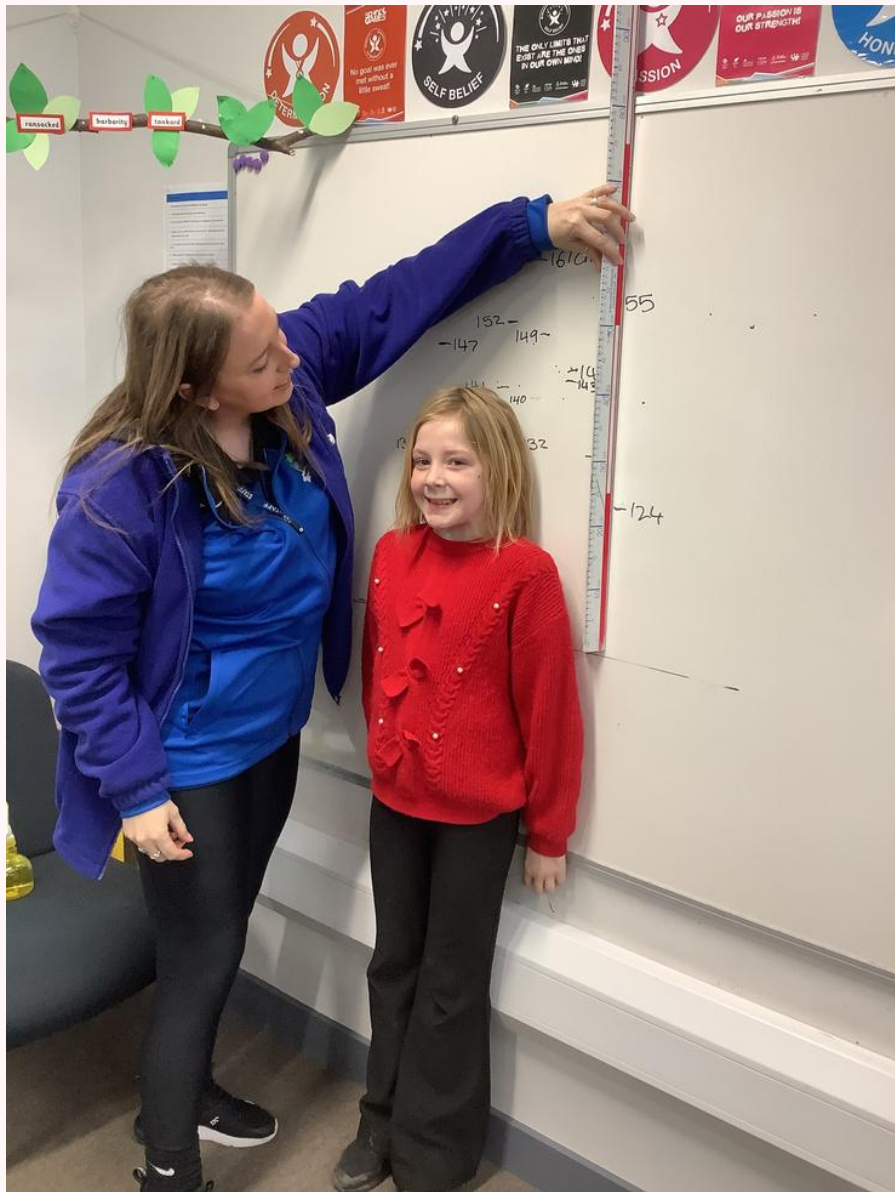


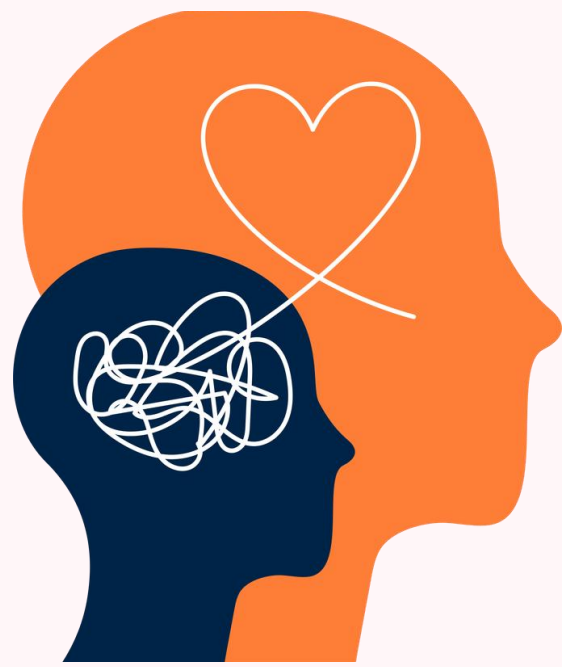


Science 13.03.26



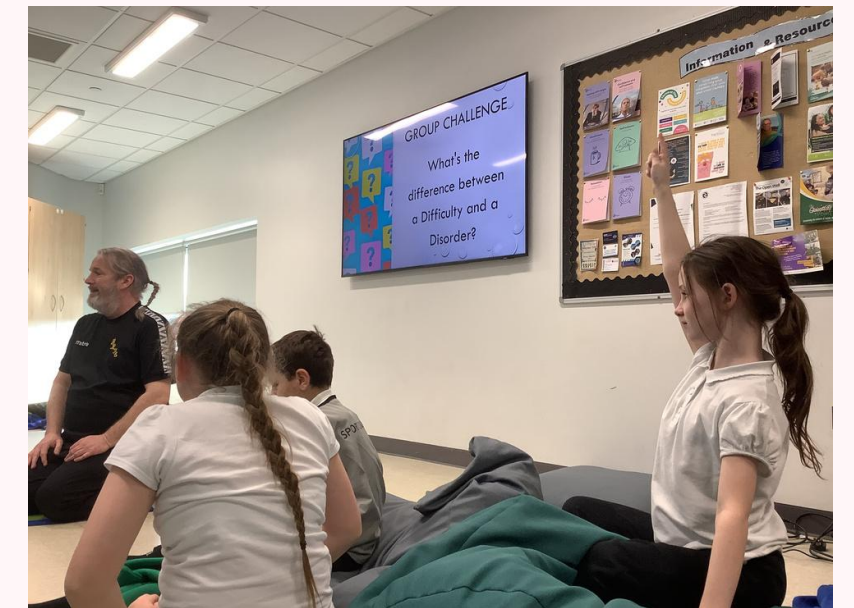
We discovered that the age of a shark can be determined by their size. Using this theory, we carried out an experiment to see if this concept would also work for children.

To celebrate Red Nose Day 2026, we wore silly outfits and styled our hair in silly, crazy ways!

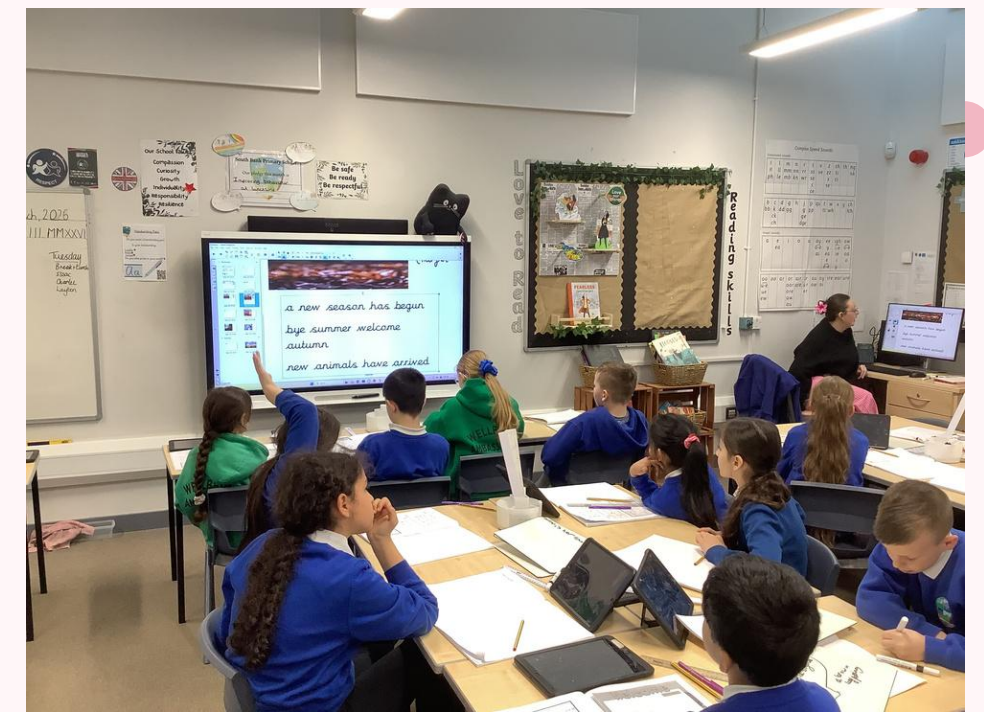
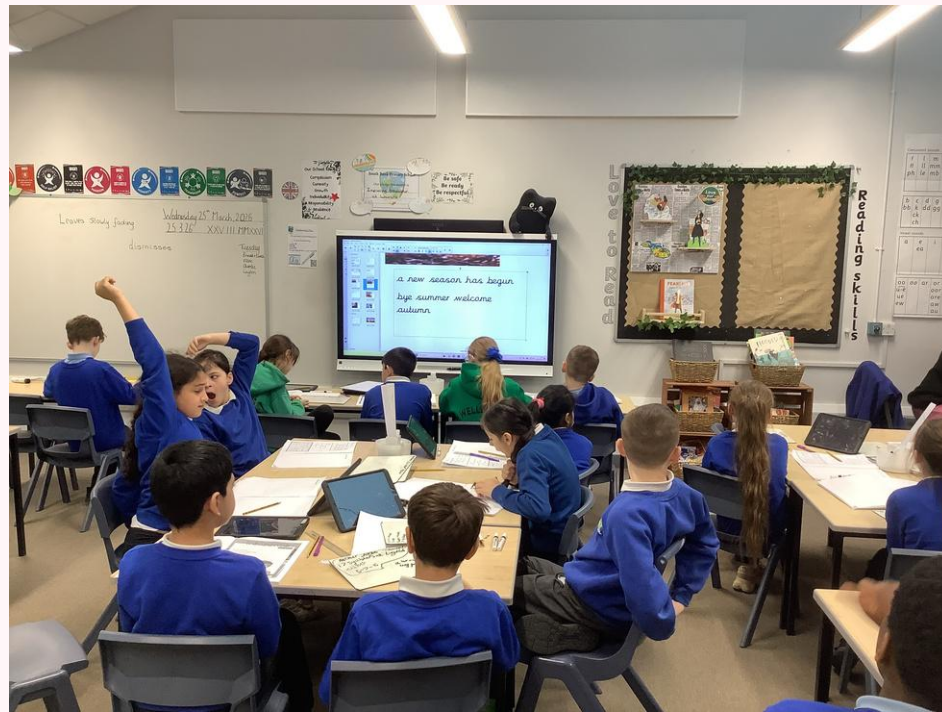


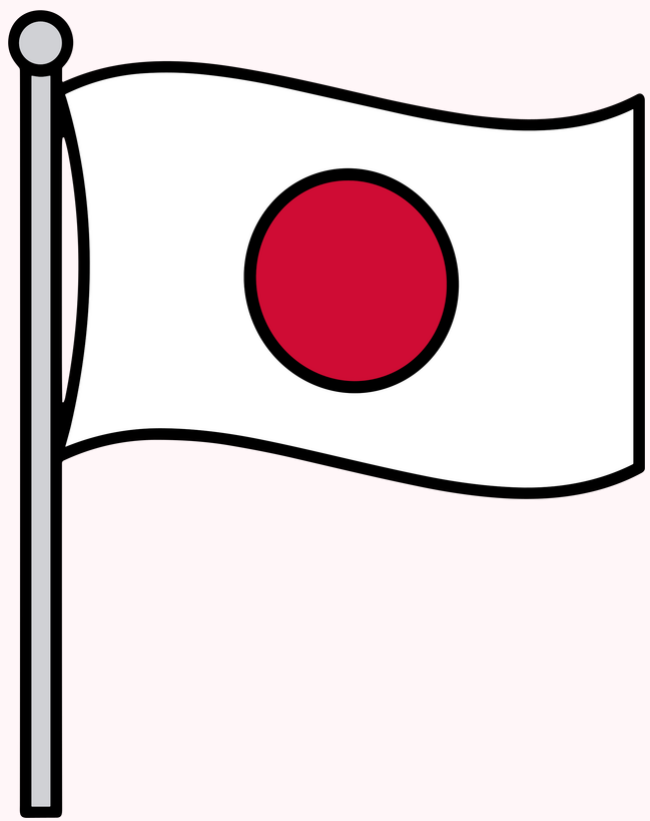


English 25.03.26

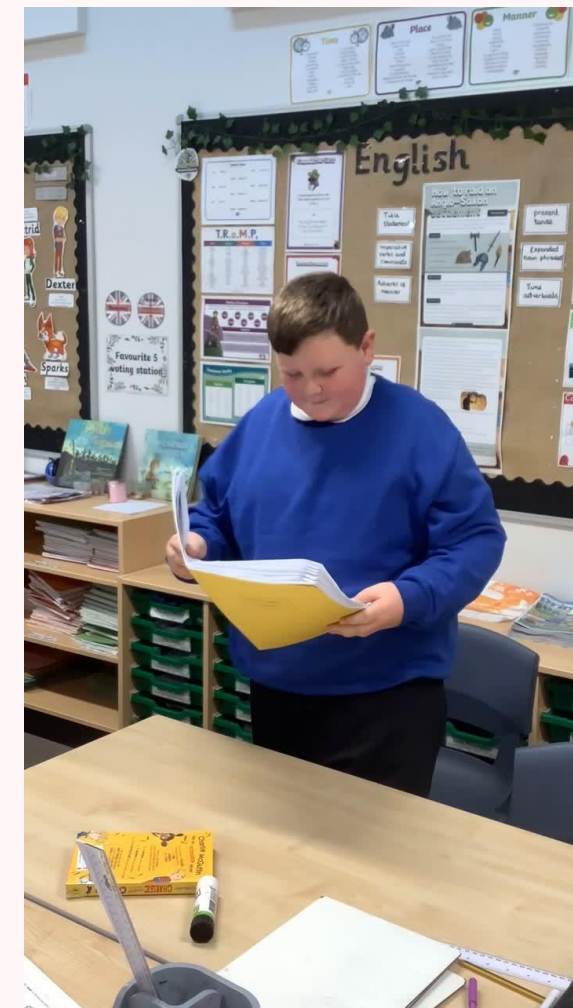
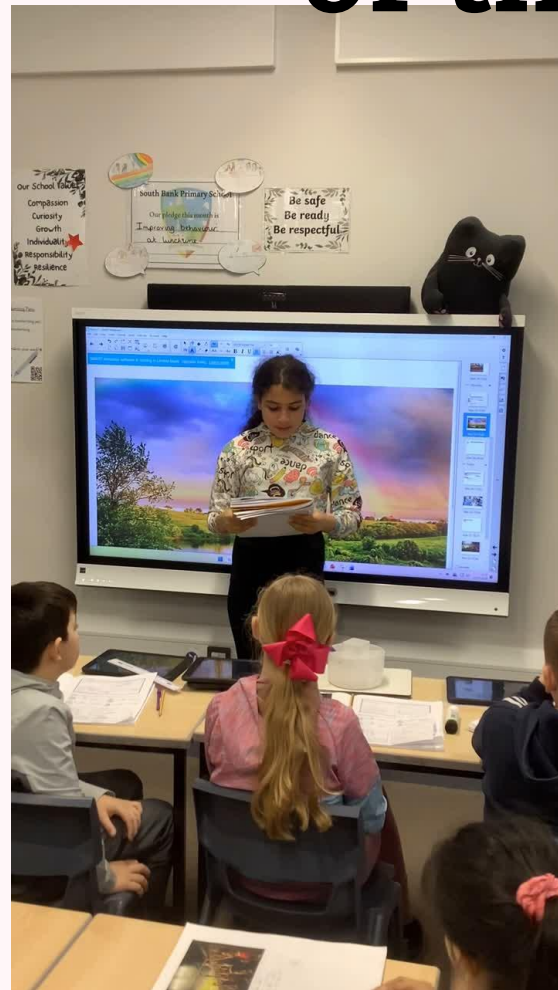
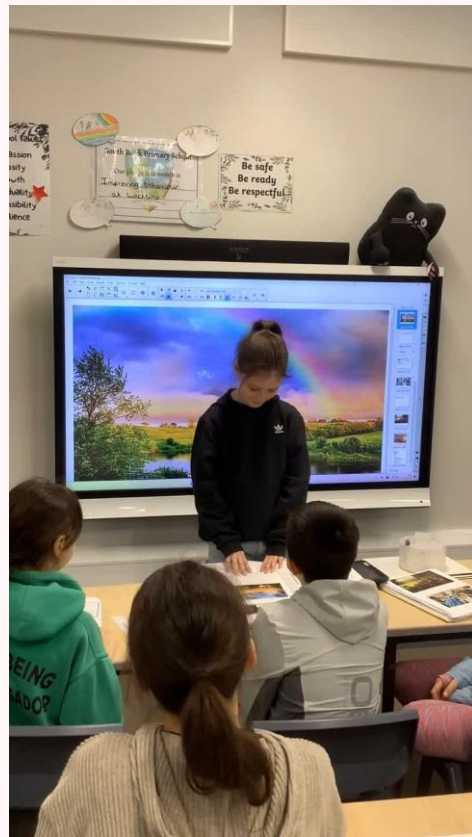
