

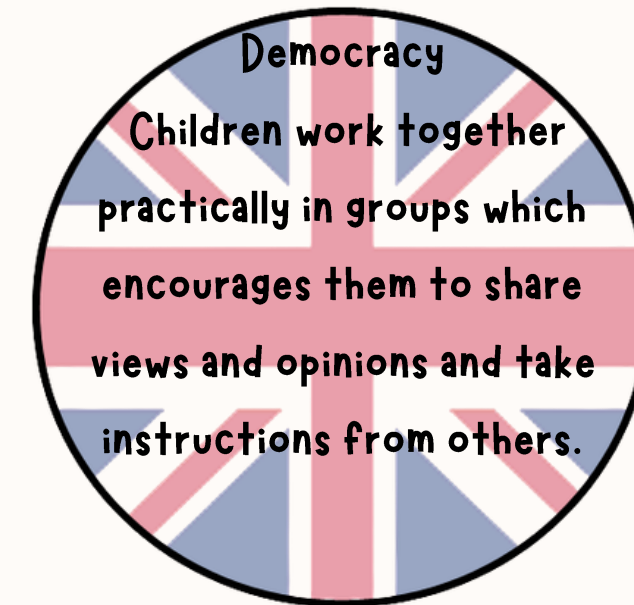

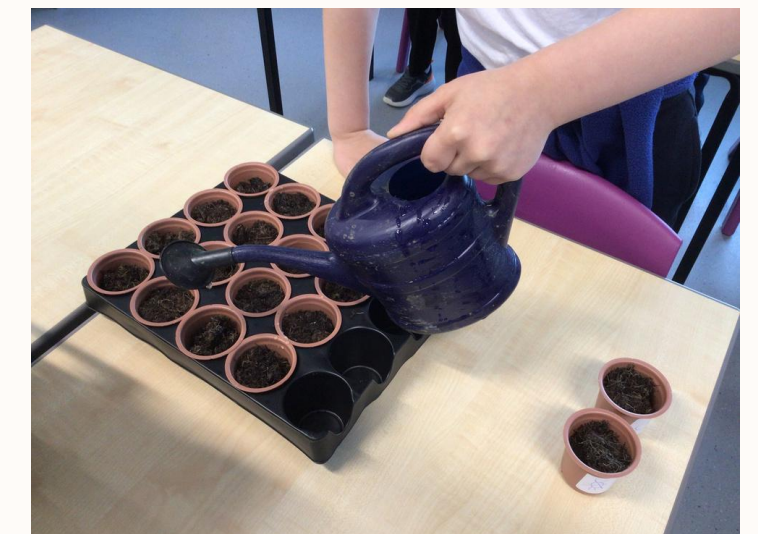


# Science

We began our Ball Skills: Hands 2 topic by practice throwing and catching the ball. We added a hoop into the game and practice throwing into a target.

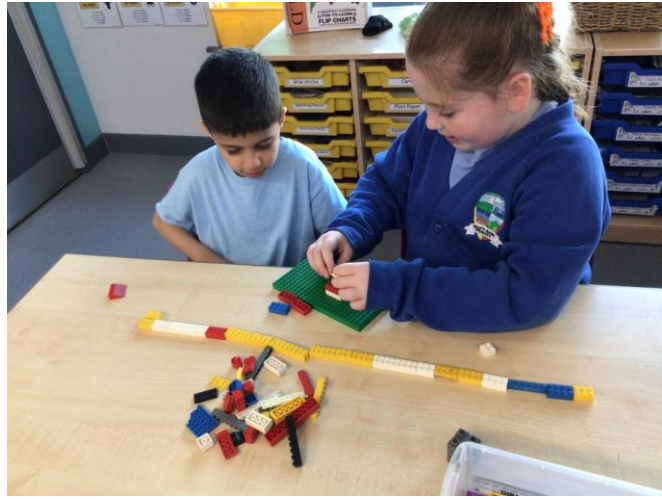


To increase the difficulty, we changed the height of the hoop and direction of the hoop. This allowed us to practice different types of throws.

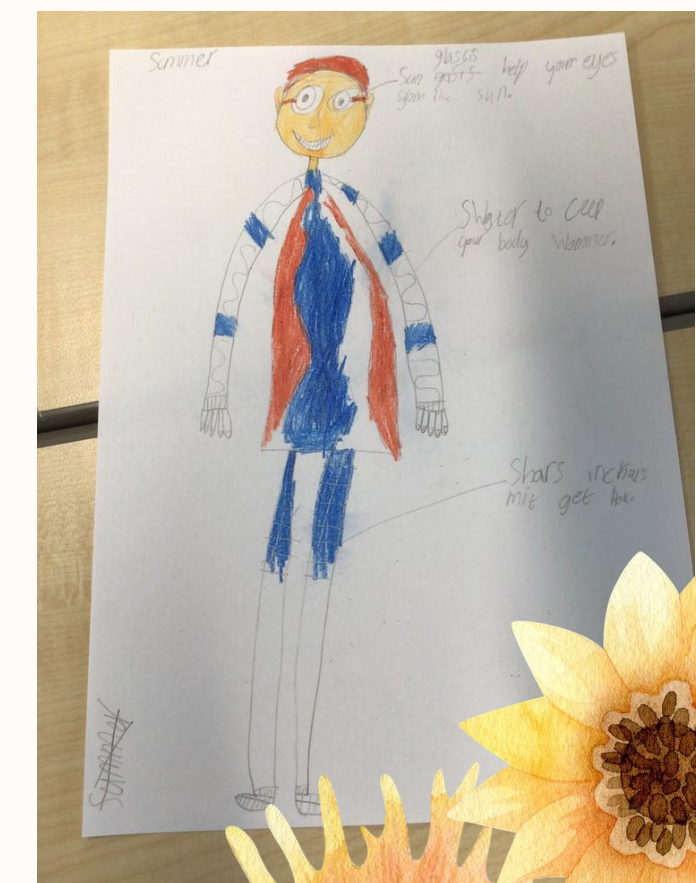
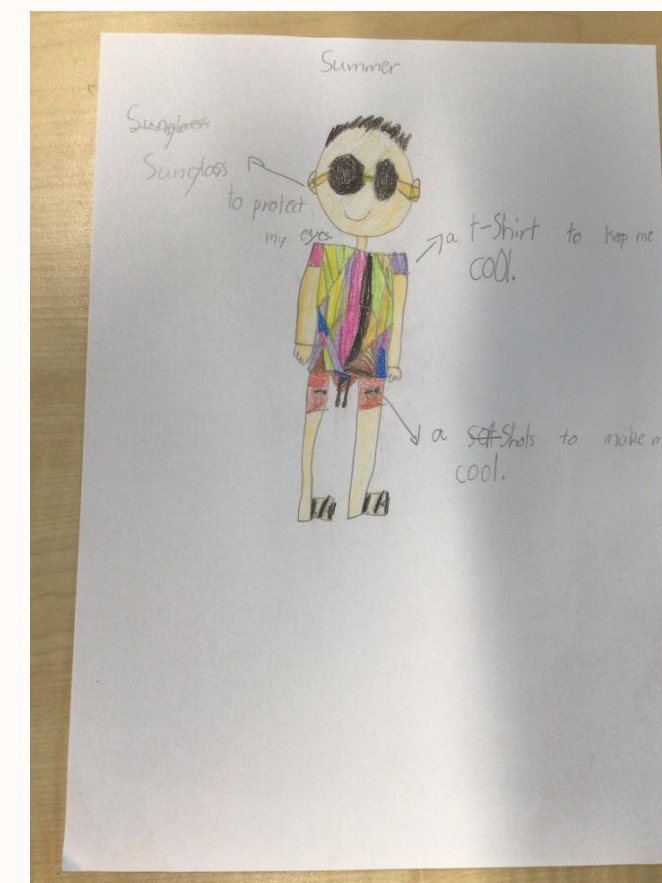
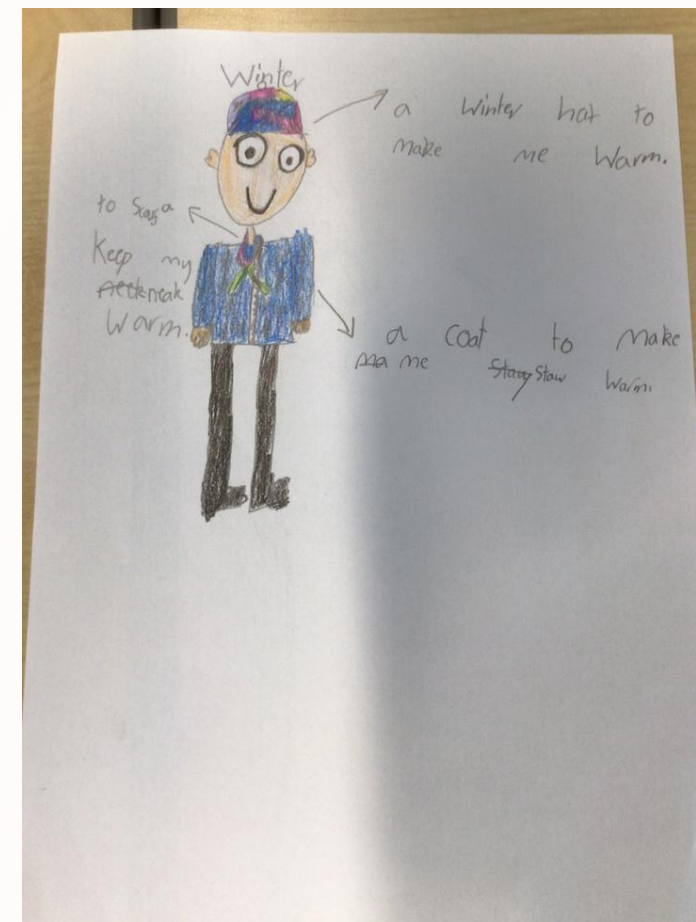
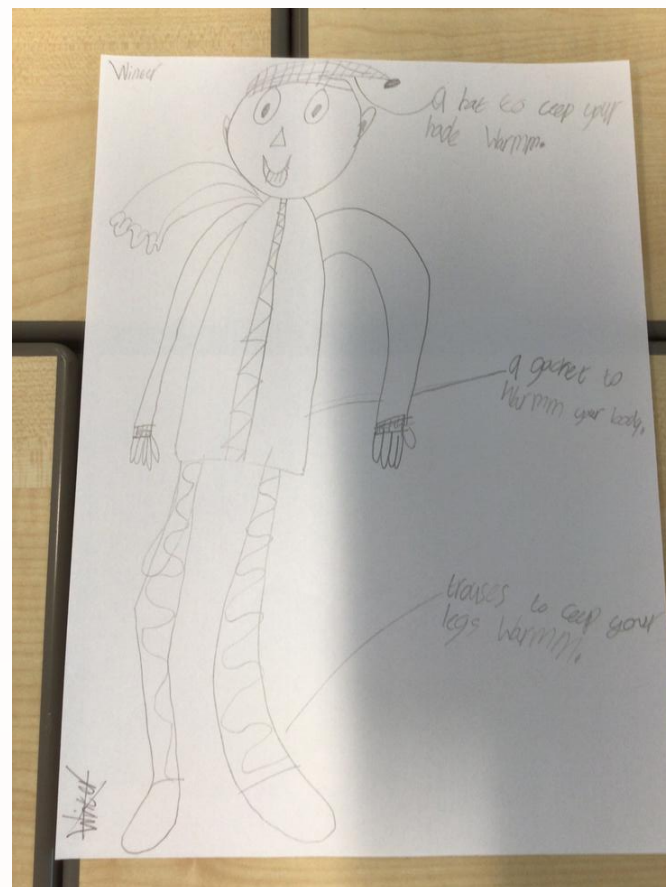
**The children had to work in teams to build a tower out of building blocks. We then discussed what when we'll and what didn't go well.**

**Every child has the right to food, clothes and a safe place to live.**



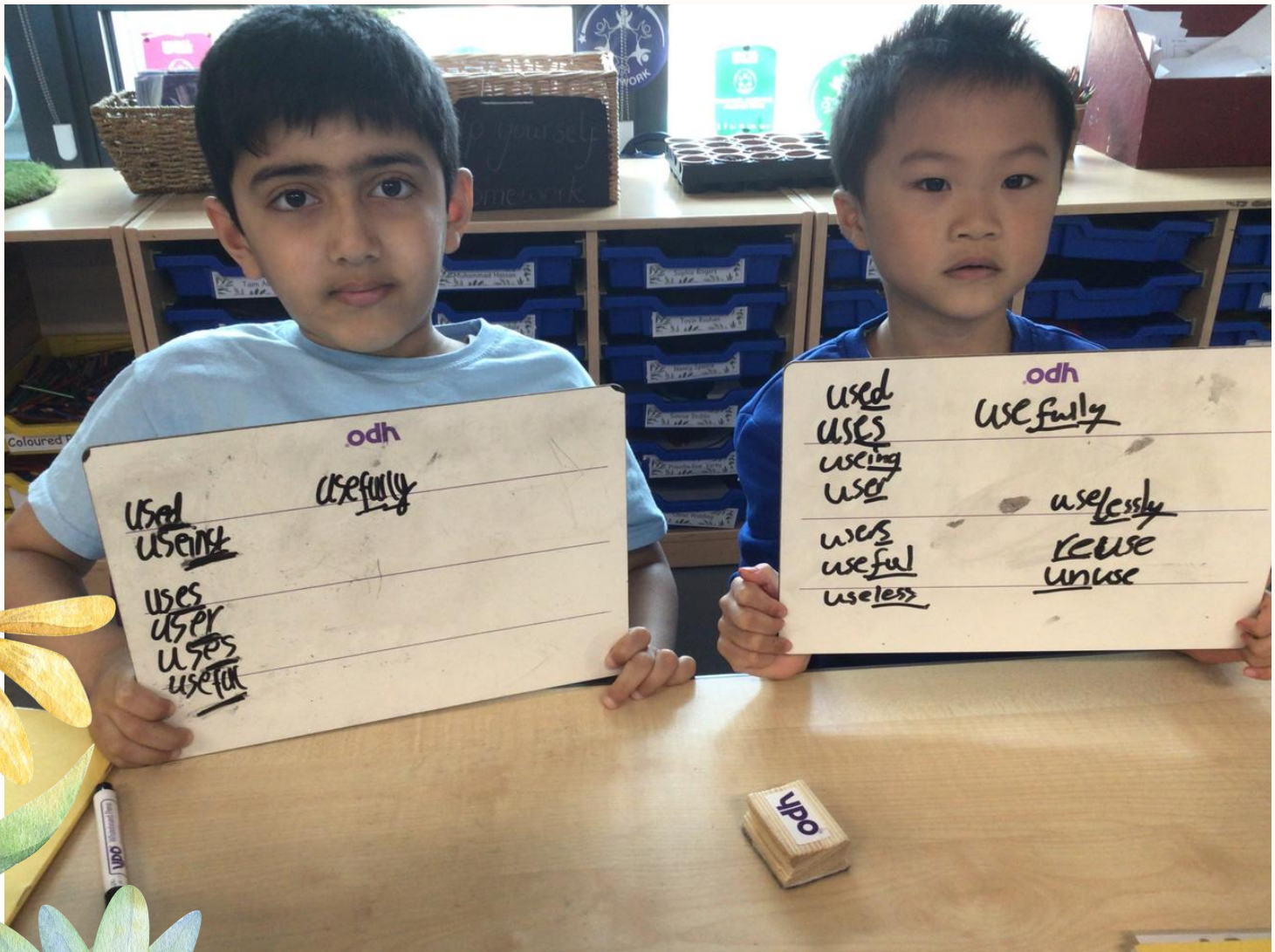
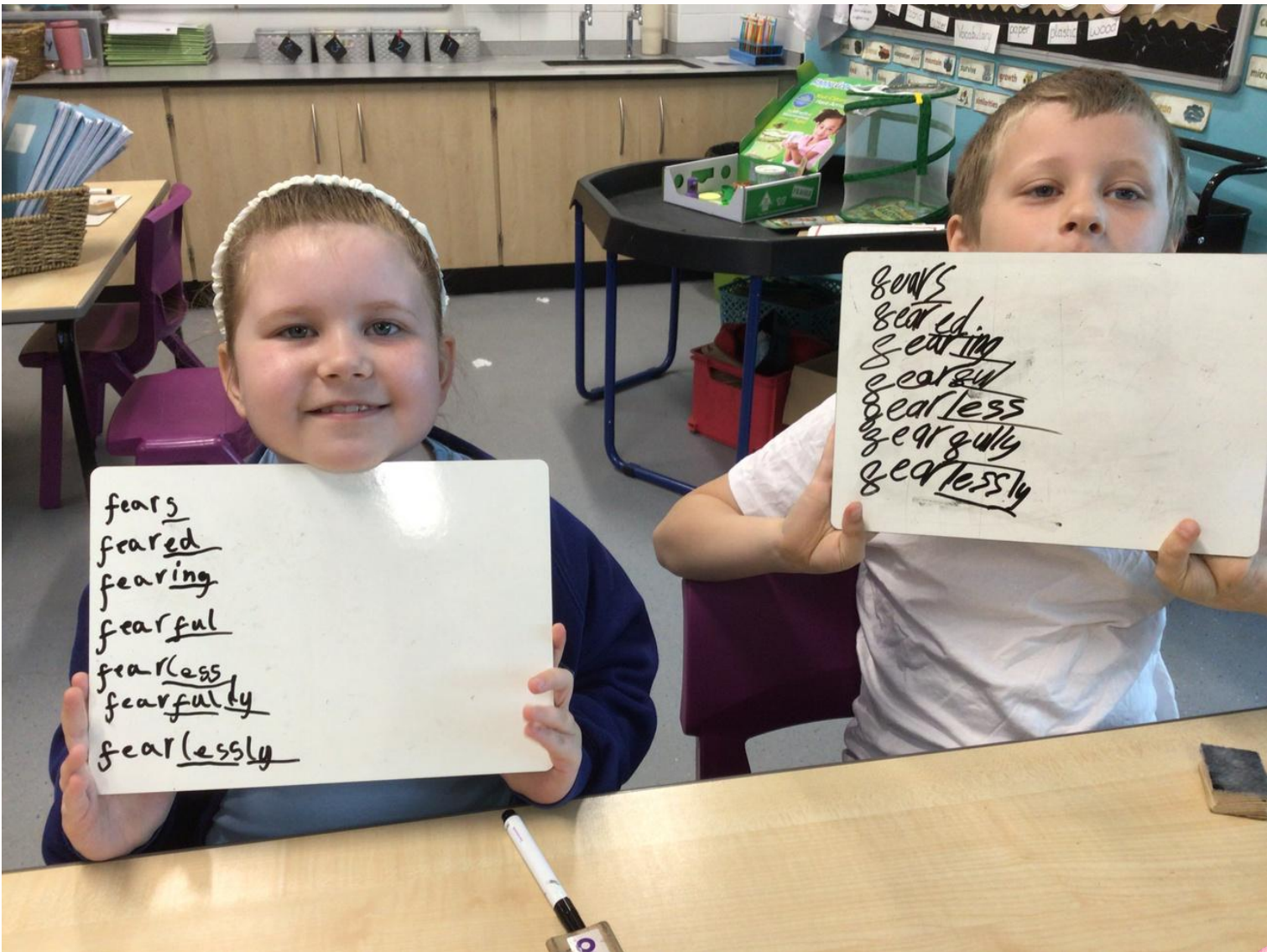
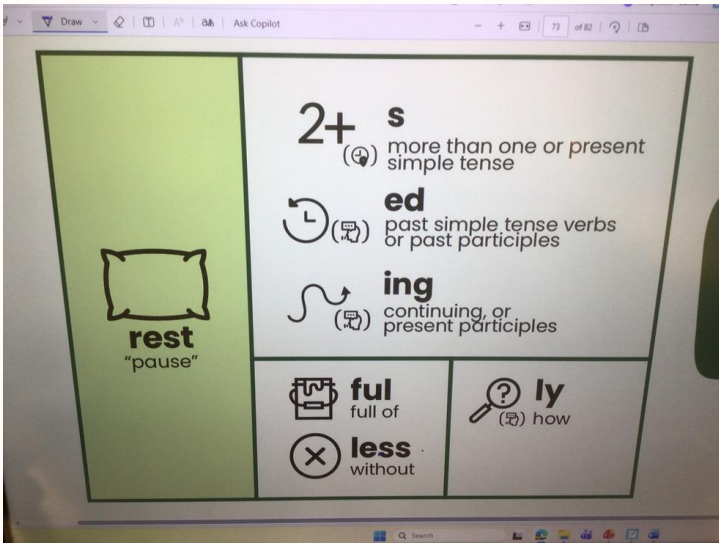

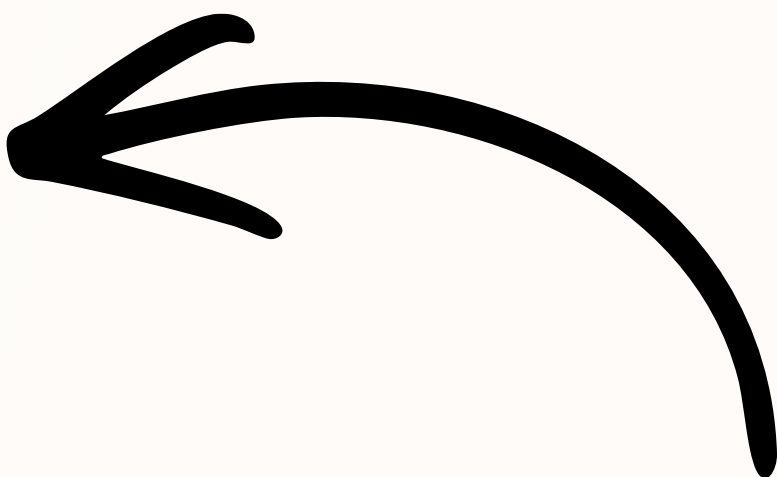
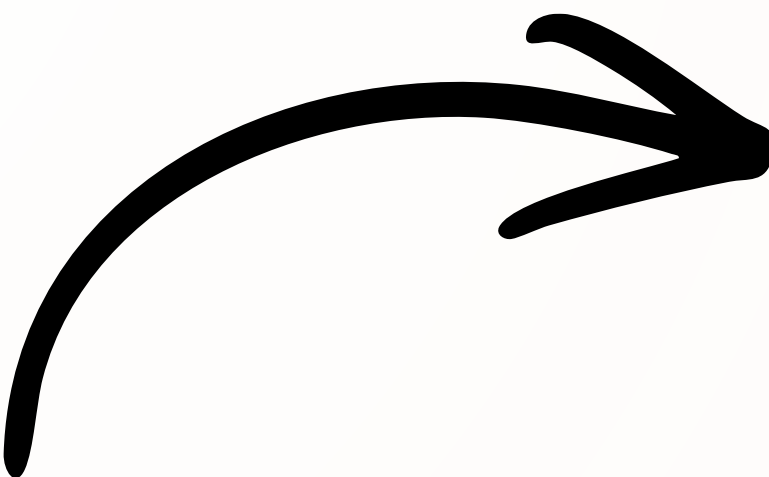
# English - Spelling Matrix

We observed the changes made by caterpillars over this half term

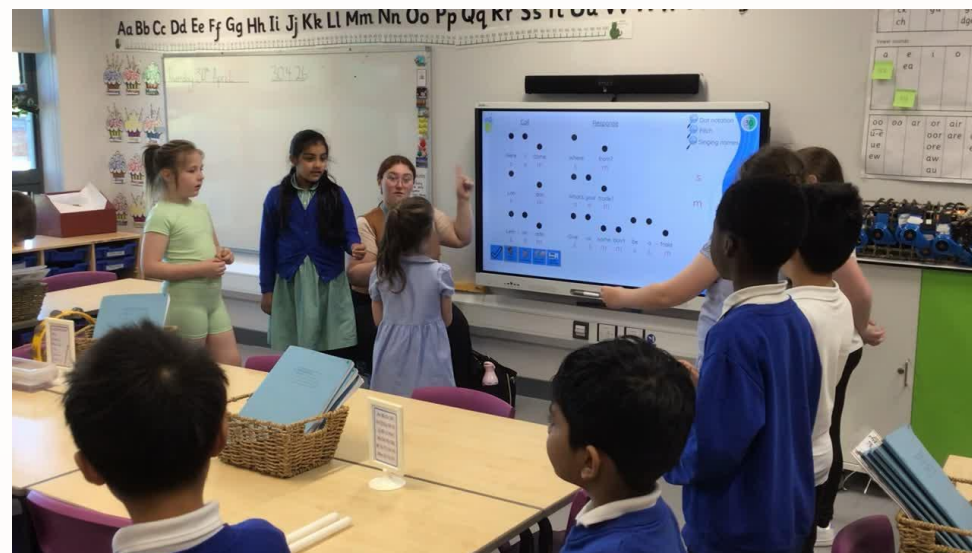




# Music

# Art 8/5/2026

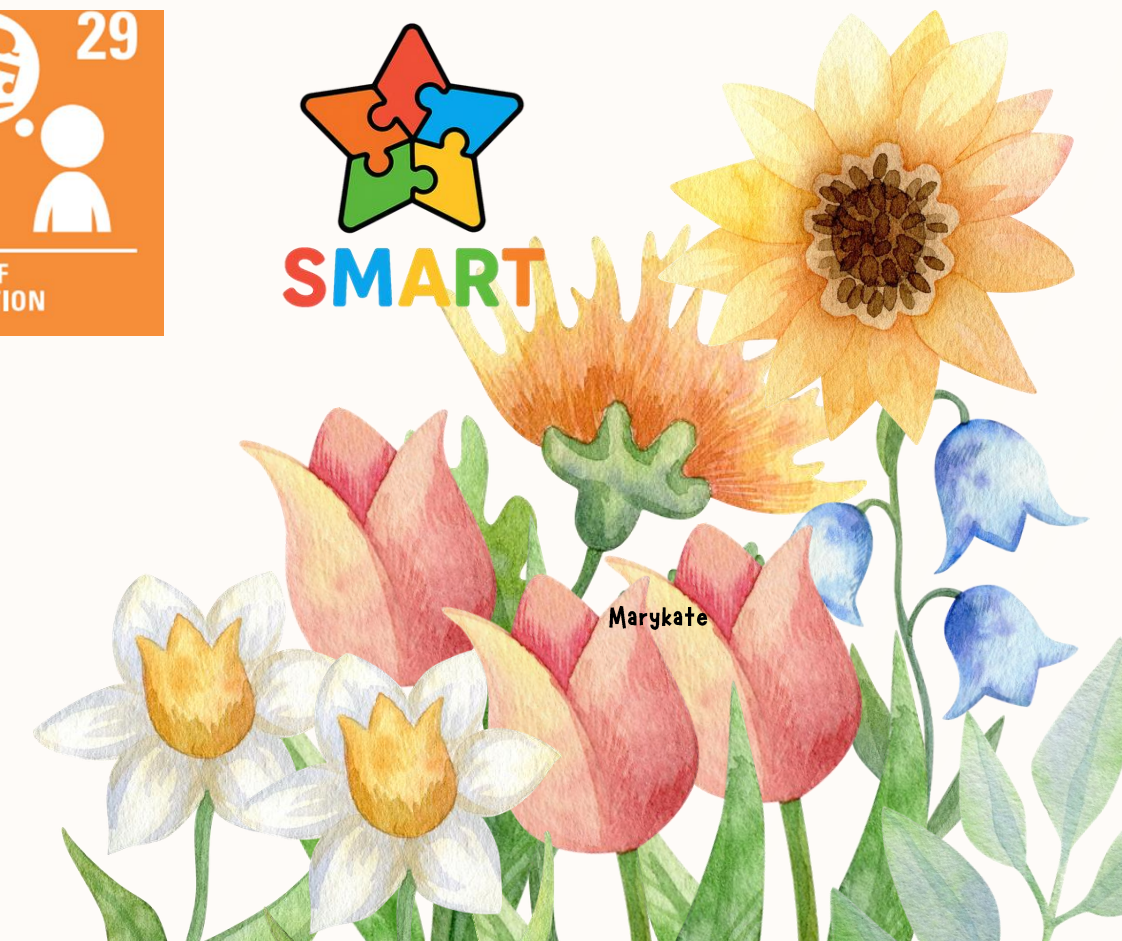
The children have made their

**We then discussed as a class what we could of done better in our groups.**

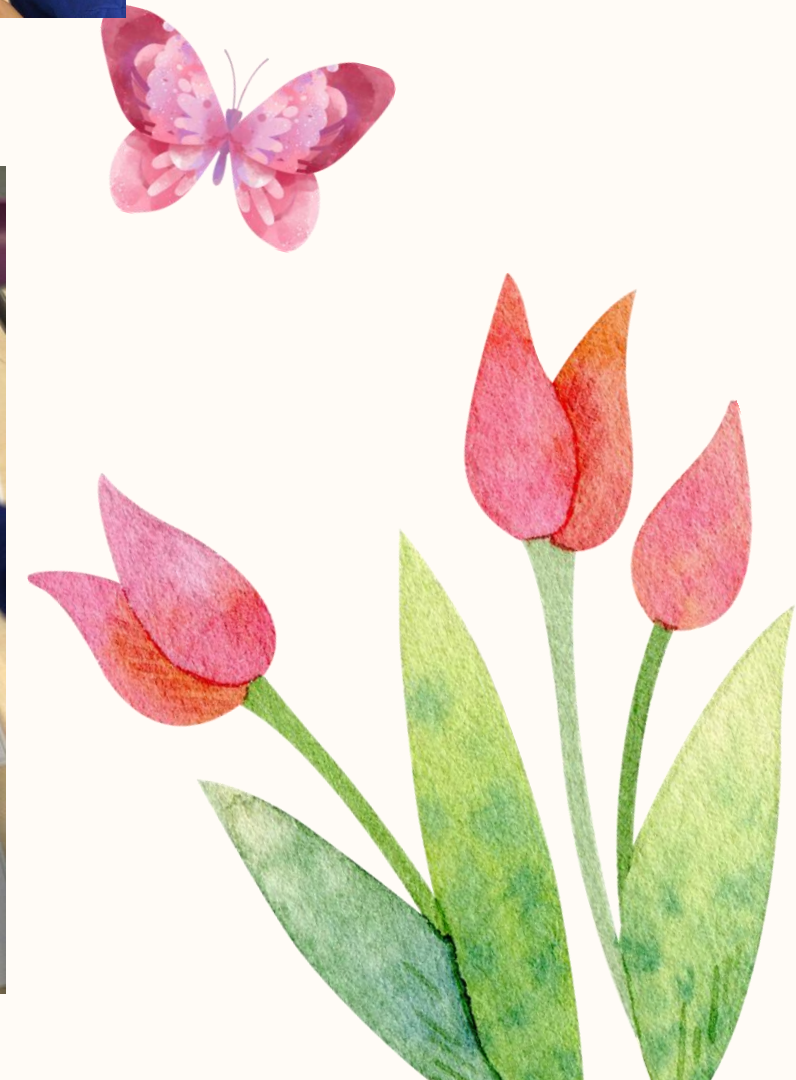




# Jigsaw Relationship 19/5/26

# Music 21/5/26



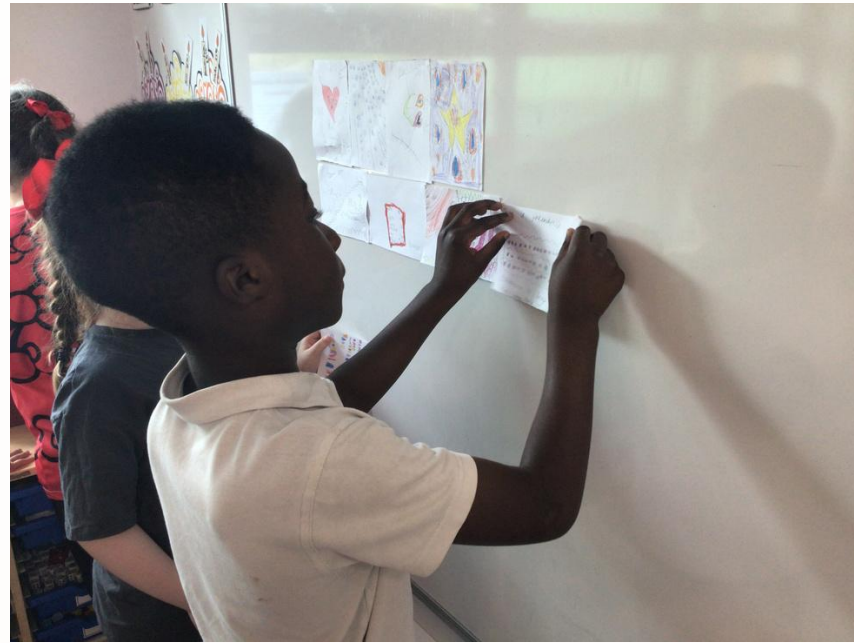
