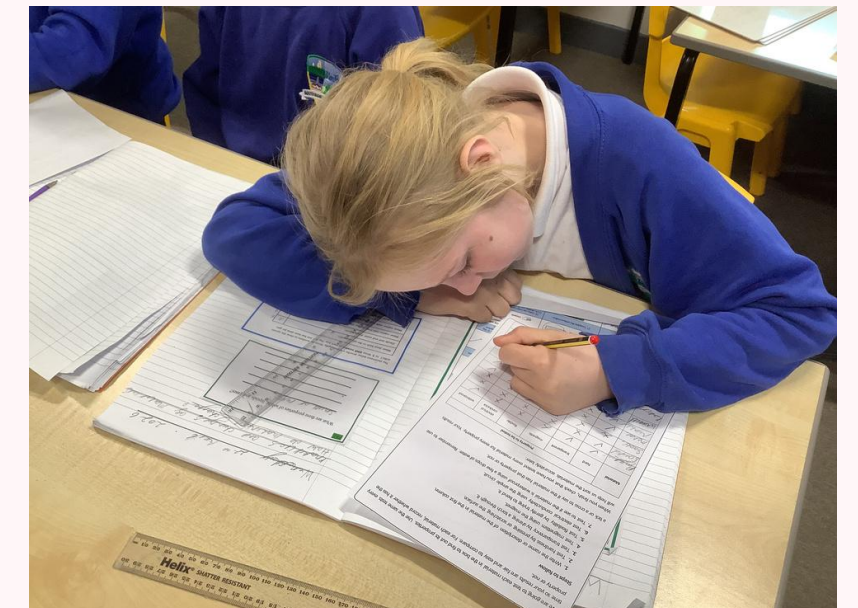
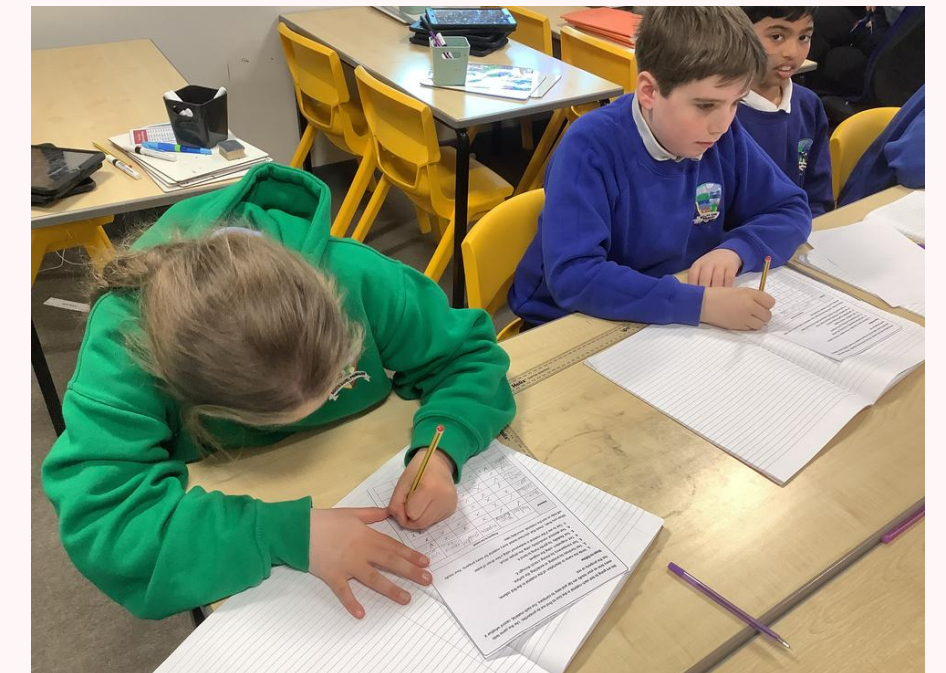
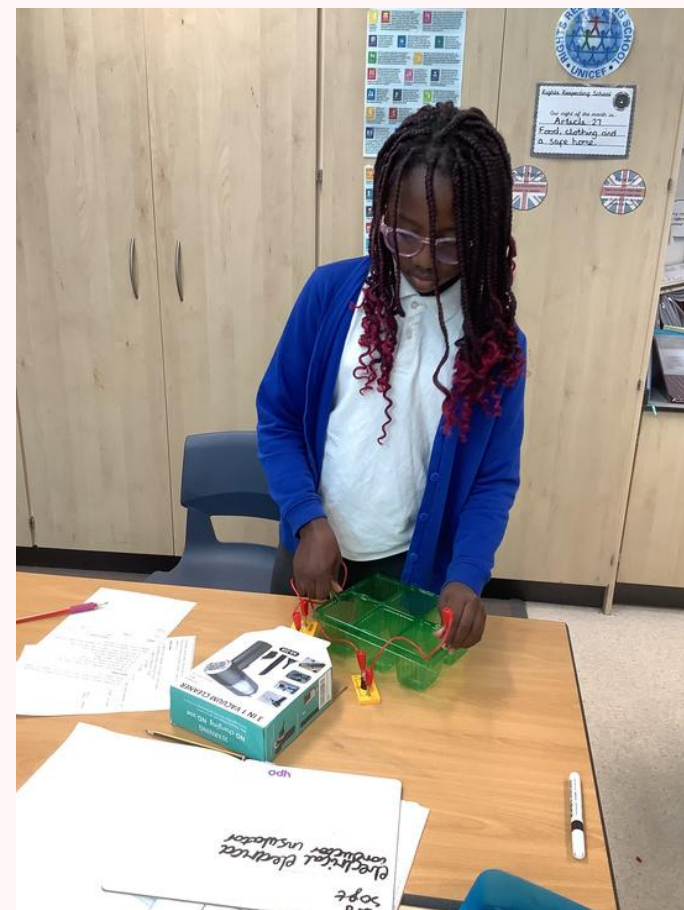
In our lesson today, we have been learning how to say continents and countries in french. As a class, we practiced speaking about the different countries we have visited.

In Computing, we started to learn how to make a successful keynote.

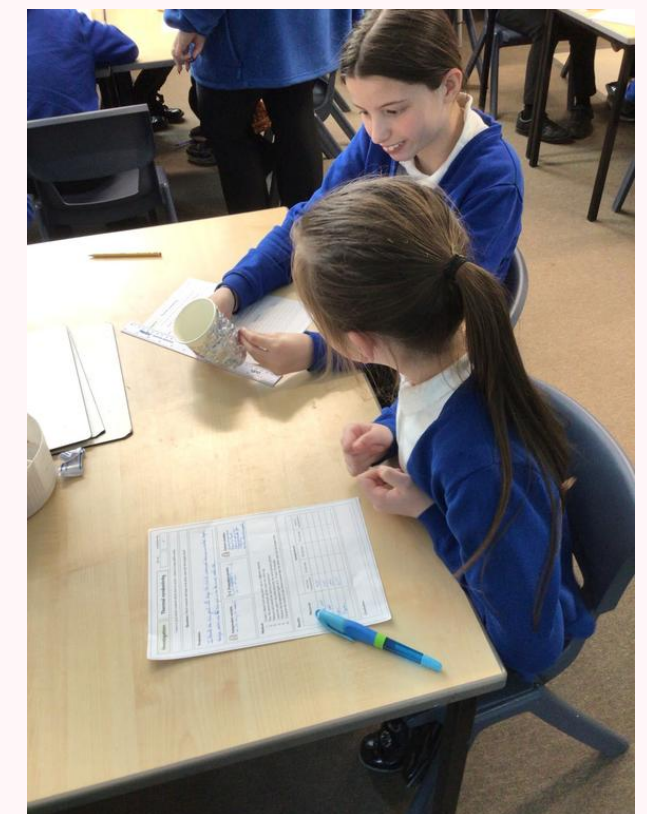
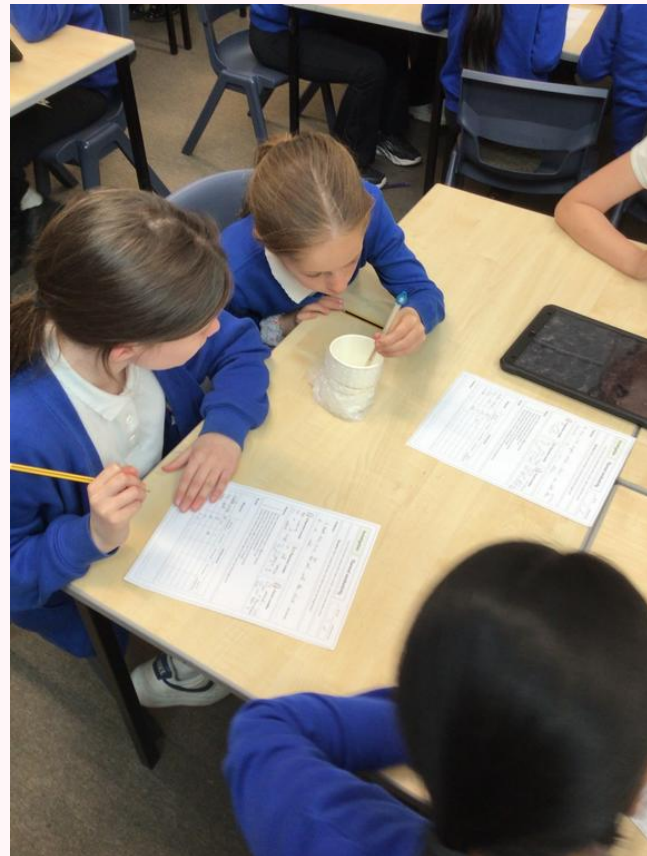
We followed instructions from Spark and enjoyed the challenge!

STEM trip to Yarm Prep School 7.5.26

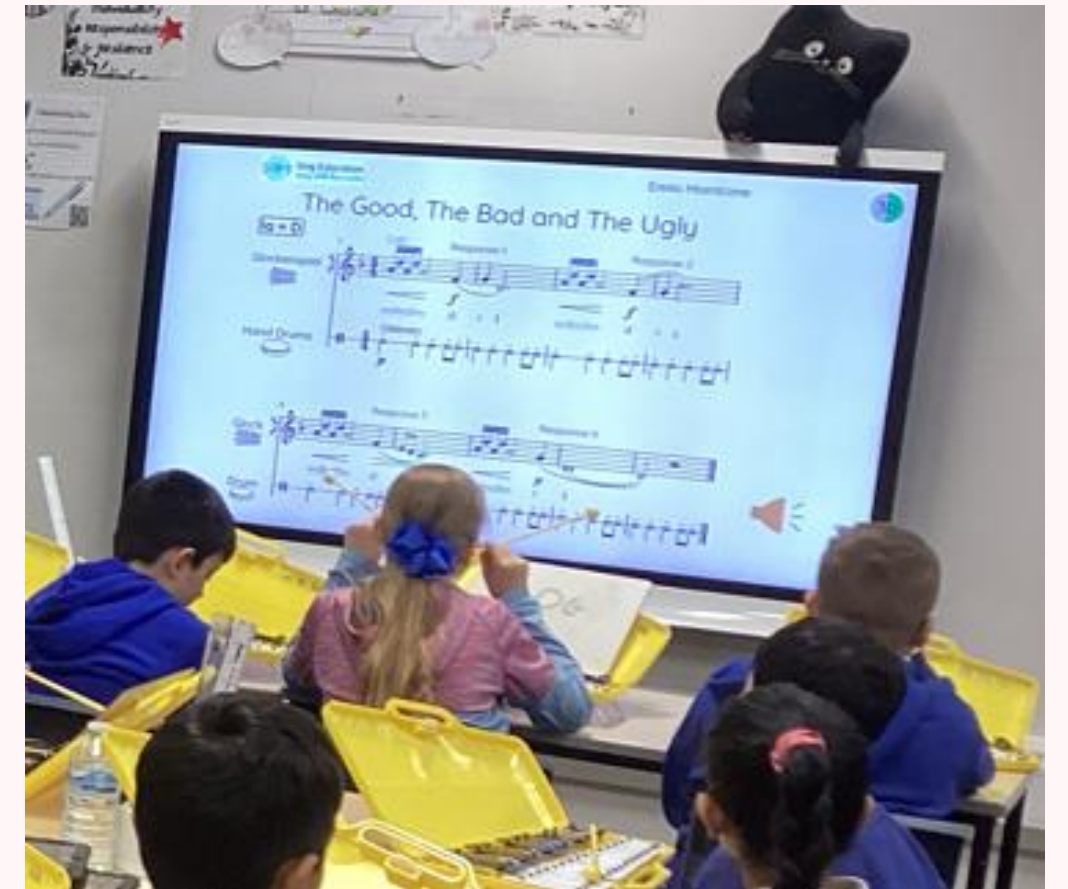
Today, we visited Yarm Prep school to take part in STEM experiments run by local businesses. We made our own DNA and controlled robots with sensors!



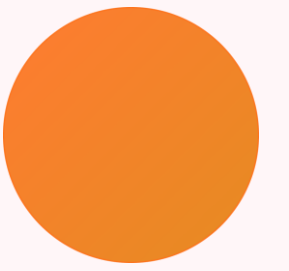
Music

We have also learnt to listen for the beat and rhythm of music used in films/TV.

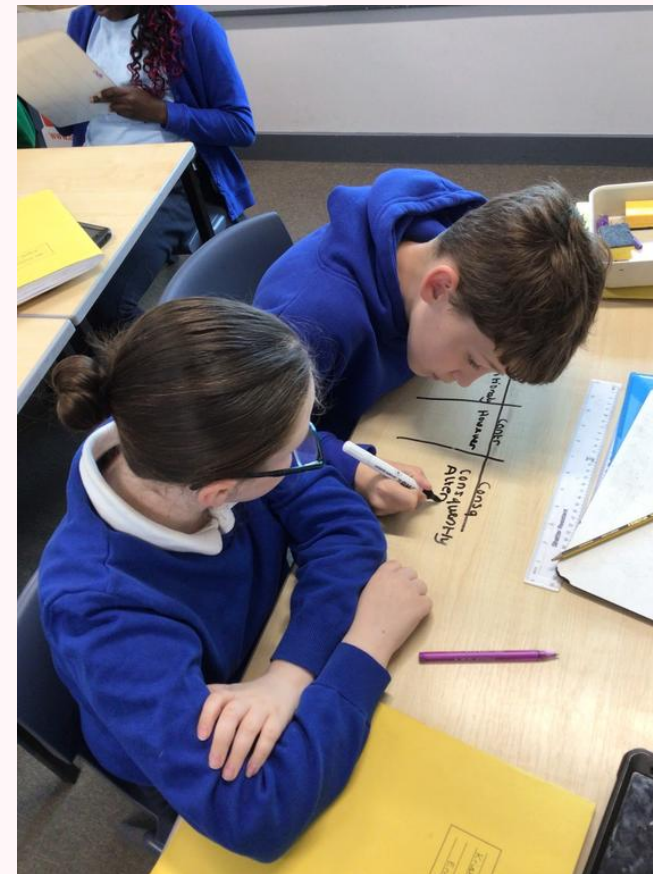


ENGLISH



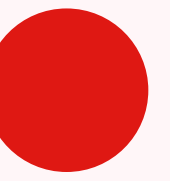

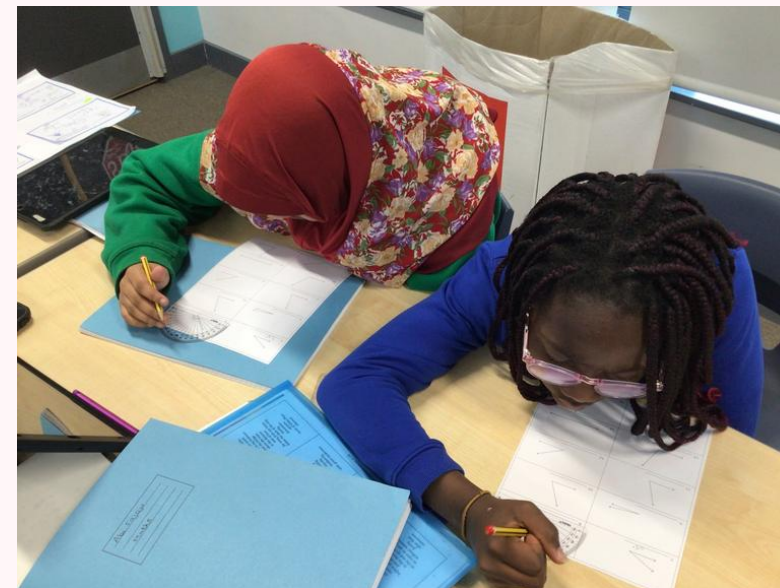
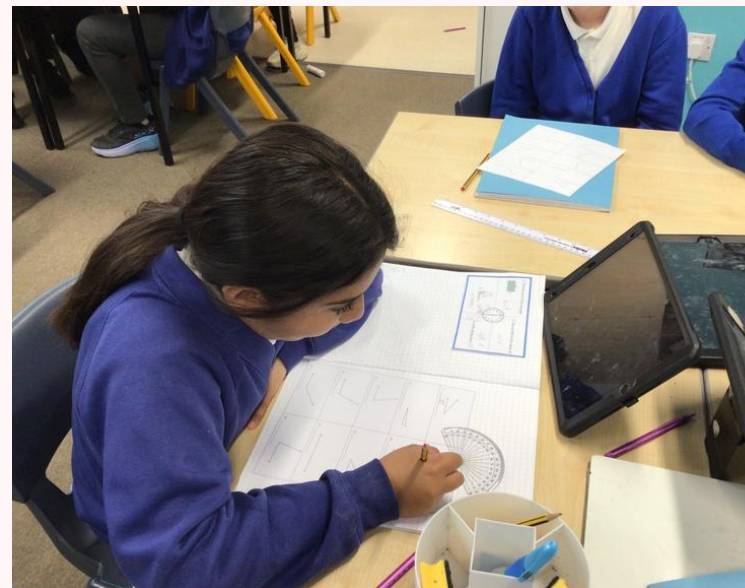
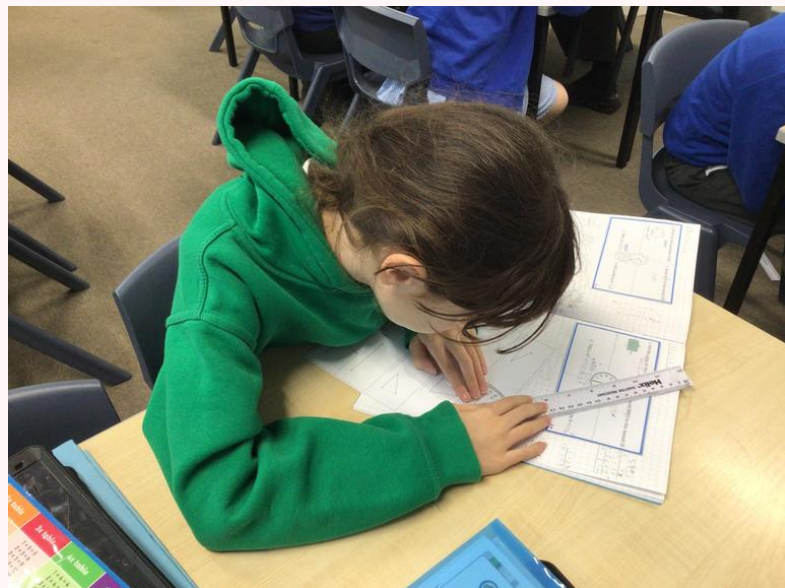


MATHS
