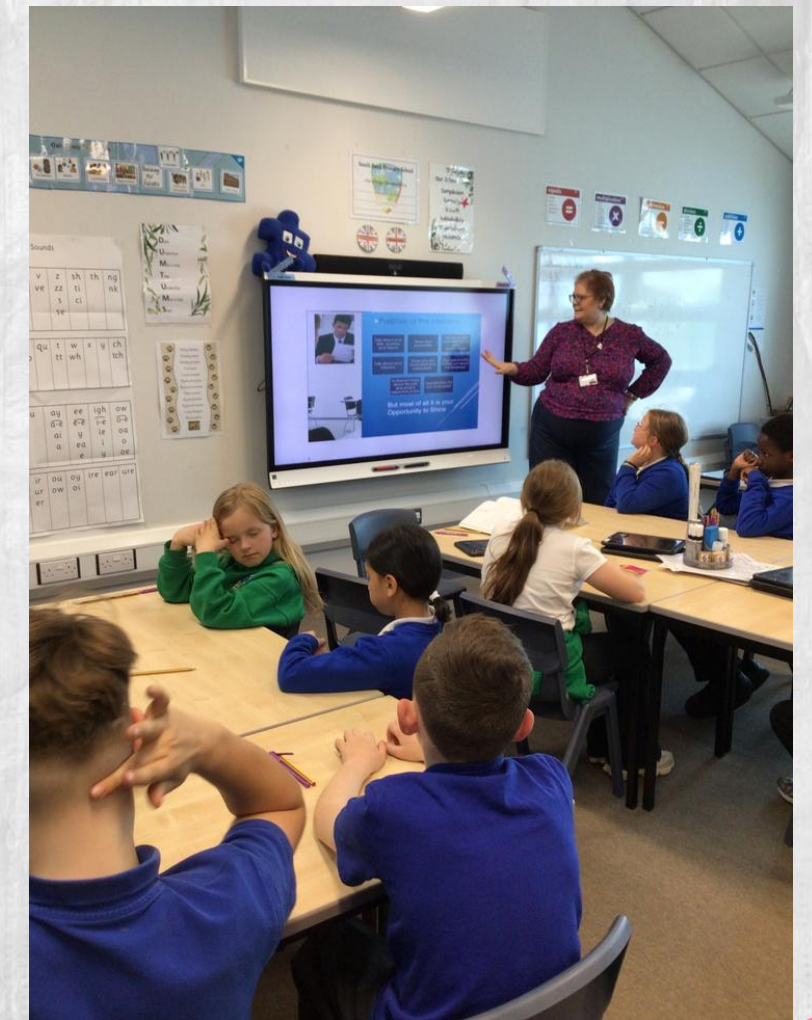


BUILDING OUR FUTURES CAREERS 21.4.26

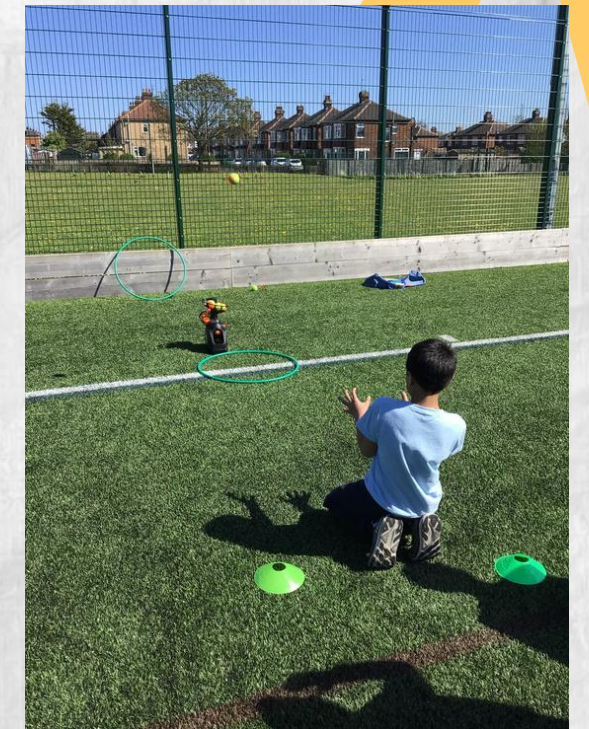

This week in Science, we have been creating simple circuits. We connected batteries and bulbs using wires. We have discussed what it means to conduct electricity.



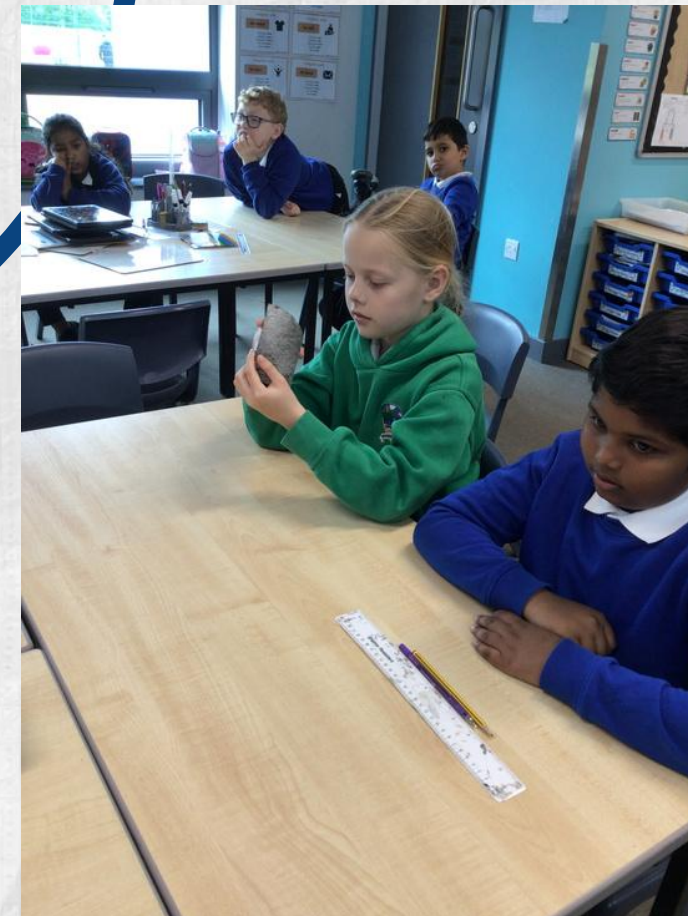

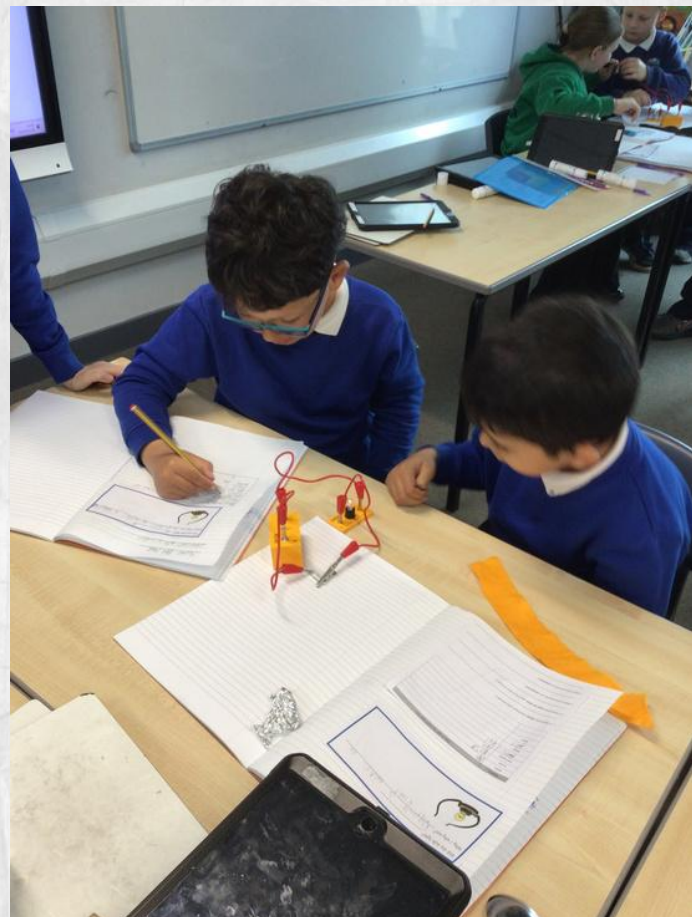
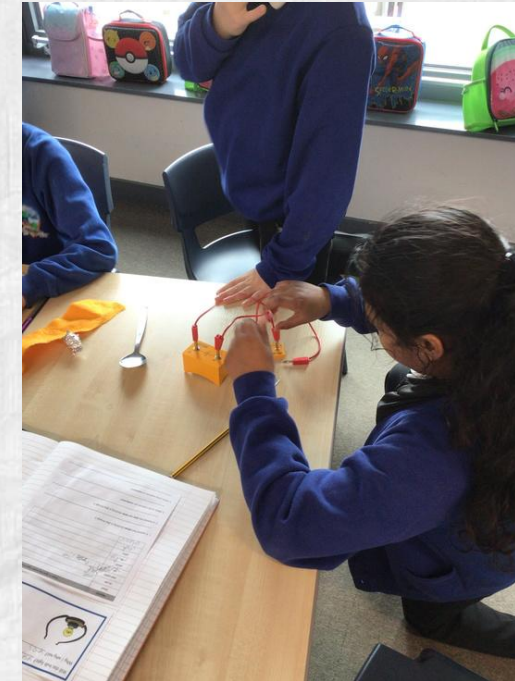
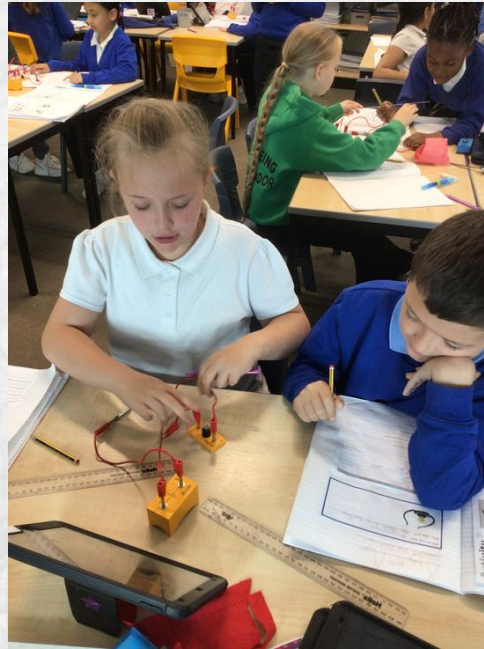
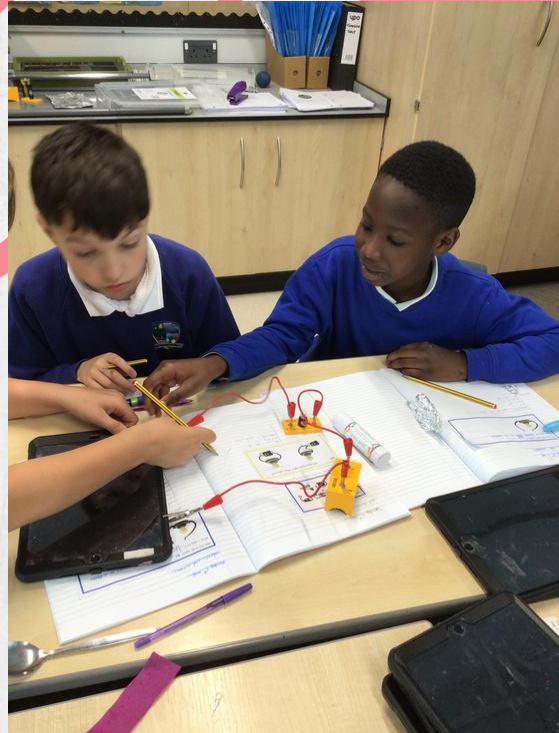


BUILDING OUR FUTURES 5.5.26
